19	Applicant is applying for a business Continued Certificate of Occupancy.
20	Applicant is renting what is known
21	as Warehouse A, as the property is divided in two parts. The client's business is located in New York
22	City and they are going to use this site solely for storage of furnishings.

2 The warehouse will house furniture for rental apartments in Manhattan and other parts 3 of the City. Operation of the business will consist of storage of furniture, and small box trucks going 4 in and out to bring the furniture in or to remove the furniture to a specific rental location. 5 Applicant, Ealerian Kopaleish 6 operations manager stated that there will be a manager and two employees on site. Four parking spaces are provided on site, for their own use. 7 8 No exterior site changes. Interior portable shelving will be used for storage of 9 furnishing. 10 Hours of operation, seven days a week. Applicant requests a 24-hour operation in 11 case of the rarity for evening hours for a pick up of furniture or a delivery. 12 Applicant will adhere and conform to 13 whatever the ordinance requires regarding hours of operation. Applicant stipulated that they will 14 comply/conform to whatever the zoning code and ordinance requires. 15 The warehouse is not and will not be 16 opened to the public. No furniture sales will take place at this location. Deliveries come in and out 17 of the rear of the warehouse, with a small 15-foot box truck. Garbage will be taken off site which 18 consists mostly of empty cardboard boxes. 19 20 21
