WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular intersection of East 54th Street and the following intersections: Willow Street and Orange Avenue; Willow Street and Elizabeth Avenue for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey, the Mayor and Council ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a "4-Way Stop" at the intersections of East 54th Street and the following intersections: **Willow Street and Orange Avenue**; **Willow Street and Elizabeth Avenue** in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated "4-Way Stop" is in the interest of the public and its health, safety, and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary "4-Way Stop" signs at the abovementioned intersections.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic," more specifically section 7-21 titled "Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the "4-Way Stop" intersection of **Willow Street and Orange Avenue**; **Willow Street and Elizabeth Avenue** as follows:

7-21 Multi-way stop intersections.

It is hereby amended to include the "4-Way Stop" intersection of **Willow Street and Orange Avenue**; **Willow Street and Elizabeth Avenue**. That traffic will stop in all directions.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance with the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 6: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: Repealer. AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH CHAPTER XXII, ENTITLED "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS," MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 22-1.15 ENTITLED "RESTORATION BY PERMITTEE" SO AS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANGUAGE CLARIFYING THE OBLIGATION AND RESPONSIBILITY SET FORTH THEREIN

INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE

The intent of this Ordinance is to amend the part of the ordinance to place a much-expanded burden on a permittee, whether that permittee is a public or private entity, to undertake the responsibility of repairing and or restoring and or replacing pavement after a trench opening on any roadway of the Borough.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware that there exists, with regards to the conditions of many of the Boroughs streets, as a result of street opening and the effect that it has on the health and safety of the residents of the Borough, resulting in improper repaving by a permittee which causes unlevel and uneven pavement of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have concluded that these created conditions referred to above have become a hazard to the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter XXII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, entitled "Streets and Sidewalks," more specifically section 22-1.15 entitled "Restoration by Permittee," is hereby amended and replaced with the following language:

- A. The Borough may grant permission on the permit to the permittee to permanently restore, with his own employees or a contractor approved by the Borough, the pavement in a manner satisfactory to the Borough. Temporary restoration of pavement is to be made immediately after the trench has been properly backfilled and compacted, and the permanent restoration of the pavement shall be made within three months, weather permitting, from the date the temporary pavement was installed, and such permanent restoration shall, as nearly as possible, duplicate the original pavement in type material, color, and texture of the surface. The term "pavement," as used in these regulations, shall include the foundation for the surface of the roadway, except where penetration pavement existed, in which case it will be necessary for the permittee to replace the surface with Type 1 material, or such material as required by the Borough Engineer.
- B. When the trench opening is perpendicular on the roadway that being curb to curb or any part thereof, the width of the permanent pavement restoration shall be extended for a minimum of ten (10) feet on each side of the trench and beyond the limits of the temporary pavement restoration and shall be saw-cut or milled to form a straight stable edge of the existing bituminous surface.
- C. When the trench opening is horizontal to the roadway, then and in that situation, the width of the permanent pavement restoration shall be extended curb to curb on each side of the trench for the length of the trench the pavement restoration and shall be milled to abut the curbs on both sides of the roadway. Should there not exist any curbs, then in such event, a stable edge of the pavement restoration shall be milled to form a straight stable edge of the existing bituminous surface and or gutter portion of the roadway.
- D. All struck edges, and the overlapping surface edge shall be coated with asphaltic cement to bind the bituminous concrete to the surrounding existing bituminous concrete.
- E. The permanent pavement restoration shall be HMA 95M64, 12M64, or an equivalent surface course applied as specified by the Town Engineer.
- F. Newly restored bituminous surfaces shall be at least two and one half inches thick following compaction and level with the original grade and section.
- G. All saw-cut edges of the existing bituminous surface shall be tact coated and sealed to form a water-tight flexible seal between the two roadway surfaces.

SECTION 2. In the event any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, the Planning Board shall within 45 days after referral by the Borough Council, transmit to the Borough Mayor and Council, a report containing its recommendation concerning the redevelopment plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7 & 15; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the Planning Board's recommendation or if the Planning Board fails to transmit a recommendation within 45 days after referral, the Borough Mayor and Council shall act upon this Ordinance adopting the Redevelopment Plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough that Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 be redeveloped in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Adoption of Redevelopment Plan.

The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park hereby adopts the Redevelopment Plan entitled, "401-407 Route 46 Redevelopment Plan" dated May 2023 as the redevelopment plan for Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9.

2. Amendment of Zoning Map

The Zoning Map of the Borough of Elmwood Park, adopted as Ordinance _____ referred to in Section _____ of the Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended to reflect the Redevelopment Plan and to provide for Block 1808, Lot 7 & 9.

3. Redevelopment Entity

The Mayor and Council hereby declares that it, without the designation of any other redevelopment entity as defined in the Redevelopment Law, shall exercise all of the powers and discharge all of the duties of the redevelopment entity for purposes of clearance, re-planning, development and redevelopment of Block 1808, Lots 7 & 9 without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall be the sole body empowered by the Borough to enter into redevelopment agreements with redevelopers subject to such limitations and requirements as are prescribed by the Redevelopment Law.

4. Procedures for Amendment of Redevelopment Plan

This Redevelopment Plan may be amended from time to time, by the Mayor and Council, upon the compliance with all requirements of all applicable law.

5. Severability

If any section, sentence or any other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but shall be

confined in its effect to the section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.

6. Inconsistent Ordinance Repealed

All other ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

This section shall not apply to part-time employees who are compensated on an hourly basis.

SECTION VII: VACATION

All full-time employees shall be allowed vacation leave from their employment with the continuance of compensation provided herein, in accordance with the following schedule:

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have become aware that when a license is inactivated and or is temporarily retired, known and referred to as "POCKETING," there is no procedure to investigate that the premises where the license was used no longer continue the activity of the sale of alcohol; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park are very concerned that without an investigation of the premises to ensure that in the facilities, alcoholic beverages are longer served or sold or in any form continues to serve, sell or distributed such alcoholic beverages without the existing license; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have determined that there needs to be an assurance that such violation of the sale, distribution, and or consumption of alcoholic beverage in violation of the licensing laws of the State of New Jersey and the municipal alcoholic beverage control ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, in the State of New Jersey, that Chapter VI of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park more specifically Sections 6-4 is hereby amended to incorporate the following new section:

Chapter VI of the code entitled Alcoholic Beverages Control.

Section 6-4.9 ENTITLE INACTIVATED-TEMPORARILY RETIREMENT OF LICENSE "POCKET" LICENSE.

- a. When any license issued by the issuing authority, is presented to the agent of the municipal authority for the purpose of inactivation and or retiring from use, referred to as "Pocketing" the party owning said licenses shall certify that the premises where said license was used in no longer active and no alcoholic beverages are present on said premises and further that the activity of selling said alcoholic beverages, distributing or consumption of same is no longer practiced and that such activity is no longer perused.
- b. The agent of the Municipal authority shall at such time of accepting the license for inactivation or retiring referred to as "pocketing" shall forthwith contact the responsible assigned agent in the Police Department and advise and make that person aware of the for inactivation or retiring referred to as "pocketing."
- c. The assigned agent of the Police Department vested with the investigative role of investigating all issuances of alcoholic beverage licenses the duty to investigate and ensure that the premises where the license was used no longer serve, sell, distribute, or serve Alcoholic beverages in any form.
- d. Any violation of consumption, distribution, sale, or service of alcoholic beverage where a license was inactivated and or retired "Pocketed" shall be a violation of the license and will subject the owner of said license to fines and suspensions and or revocation of said license in violation to the laws of the state of New Jersey and Local municipal Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other terms and provisions of Chapter VI of the

Borough Code shall remain unchanged.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
