### BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK

### ORDINANCE # 15-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XXXIV OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ENTITLED "ZONING AND SITE PLAN REVIEW".

This zoning amendment would replace in its entirety the C-L Local Commercial Zone with a new N-C Neighborhood Commercial Zone; with the exception of the C.L. District fronting on Broadway between East 53<sup>rd</sup> Street and East 55<sup>th</sup> Street.

### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the new N-C Neighborhood Commercial Zone is to provide for Use, Lot and Bulk Regulations which will encourage private Reinvestment and Renewal along the Market Street Commercial Area. The guiding principles and objectives of this Zone are as follows:

- 1. Provide for a coordinated streetscape design in accordance with the Counties and Boroughs current street improvement program.
- 2. Provide for public open spaces and Municipal facilities.
- 3. Establish realistic/implementable minimum lot area requirements.
- 4. Provide for a contemporary array of balanced mix uses which will strengthen the area and serve the community's needs.
- 5. Provide development bonus incentives which will create better scaled, more cost effective development patterns.
- 6. Provide for pedestrian friendly development, which is safely accessible from adjoining residential neighborhoods.
- 7. Provide for wider sidewalks and streetscape design improvements consistent with Bergen County improvement criteria.

### PROPOSED REVISIONS

- 1. Revise Article V Districts and Zoning Map, Section 34-5 Establishment of Districts, and Subsection 34-5.1 to add as a new District the N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District.
- 2. Revise Article V Districts and Zoning Map , Section 34-5 Establishment of Districts , and Section 34-5.2 Zoning District Map to add the N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District to all current C.L. Local Commercial District locations with the exception of the C.L. Local Commercial District located on the south side of Broadway between East 53<sup>rd</sup> street and East 54<sup>th</sup> Street.
- 3. Amend ARTICLE VI Use Regulations, Section 34-6 District Land Use Regulations, Section 34-7 Table of Use Regulations, and subsections 34-7.2, 34-7.3 and 34-7.4, to add as a new district the N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District specifying and listing all uses as currently permitted in the C.L.Local Commercial District.
- 4. Revise Article VIII Bulk Requirements, Section 34-16 District Lot and Bulk Regulations, Section 34-17 Table of Lot and Bulk Regulations, to add the following N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District Lot and Bulk Regulations:

- 5. Revise Article IX Supplementary Regulations, Section 34-30 Signs, and Section 34-30.2 Signs Permitted in the C-L and CO Districts by adding reference to the new N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District. Revise Article IX Supplementary Regulations, Section 34-31 Conditional Uses, and Section 34-31.12 Arcade Regulations, and Sections 34-31.12b, 34-31.12b1 by adding reference to the new N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District.
- 6. Revise Article IX Supplementary Regulations, Section 34-31 Conditional Uses to add a new Section 34-31.13 as follows:

### 34-31.13. N-C Neighborhood Commercial District Parking Expansion

Additional accessory parking adjacent to the N-C Neighborhood Commercial District is hereby permitted as a conditional use in the R-9 and R-18 Residential District subject to the following requirements:

- 1. Said additional parking shall be limited to a maximum depth of 50 feet from the boundary of the adjacent N.C. Neighborhood Commercial District; or equal to the existing width or depth of the adjacent residentially zoned lot.
- 2. No building or structures shall be permitted within the 50 foot parking area with the exception of fencing.
- 3. A buffer no less than 20 feet in width shall be established at the residential edge between the parking area and adjacent residential uses. The design of the buffer shall be subject to review and an approval by the Planning Board at the time of a major Site Plan application

### BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ORDINANCE # 15-14

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE 2015 ROAD RESURFACING PROGRAM IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$510,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the 2015 Road Resurfacing Program at various locations (including drainage improvements and curb, sidewalk and crosswalk replacement, where necessary), as set forth on a list on file with the Borough Clerk and hereby approved and incorporated herein by this reference thereto. Depending upon the contract price and other exigent circumstances, and upon approval by the Borough Council, there may be additions to or deletions from the aforesaid list. It is hereby determined and stated that the roads being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. The sum of \$510,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law, and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$510,000, and (4) \$25,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$485,000, and (6)

the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$82,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$25,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$25,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$485,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$485,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any

matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$485,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough,

and the Borough shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

### BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ORDINANCE #15-12

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE III, CHAPTER 34-3 OF CHAPTER XXXIV OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ENTITLED "DEFINITIONS AND WORD USAGE."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Article III, Chapter 34-3 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park entitled "Definition and Word Usage" is hereby amended by deleting the existing definition of "Deck" and replacing it with the following

Deck shall mean any outdoor raised platform on a dwelling creating an area used for walking, sitting, eating or any other outdoor activities with steps leading down to the ground, located in the rear of the dwelling, are uncovered and having a maximum surface are of two hundred (200) square feet. The percentage area of any deck which exceeds the maximum surface provision of this definition shall be included in the total lot area covered by the main building.

Decks placed at the same level as the finished first floor elevation and less than six (6) feet above the lowest ground surface along the perimeter of the platform, shall be permitted on residential dwellings subject to compliance with the following provisions: (iii) minimum rear yard setback of six (6) feet; (iv) minimum side yard setback of six (6) feet.

Decks placed above the finished first floor elevation or more than six (6) feet above the lowest ground surface along the perimeter of the platform, shall be permitted on residential dwellings subject to compliance with the following provisions: (i) minimum rear yard setback of ten (10) feet; (ii) minimum side yard setback of ten (10) feet.

### **SECTION 2:** Repealer

All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

### **SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

### **SECTION 4:** Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Councilman Caramagna discussed the deck ordinance for second floor dwellings. He stated that he could not attend the Board of Education meeting.

Council President Dombrowski congratulated our new Police Officer. He announced the upcoming rabies clinic. He thanked Chief Foligno and Mr. Karcz for helping to coordinate the inmates to clean around the perimeter of the County Park. He thanked the Chamber of Commerce for paying for the lunches for the inmates. The Council President further discussed major concerns he has with the condition of the Library building, including a hole in the roof, squirrels gaining entrance to the building, broken curbing and unsafe doorways. These issues exist while the Library Board has \$1.4 million in the capital account. He stated that he sent an e-mail to the Mayor and Council advising them of the issues. He did not violate the Open Public Meeting Act. He stated the Health Inspector did an inspection and found mouse droppings and evidence of mold and squirrels. He expressed his disappointment in the Library Board in letting the building deteriorate and get to this condition. The Council President stated that the Library Board attorney sent him an e-mail stating that the Library is a Borough Building and that the Council is responsible for its upkeep. He finds that difficult to understand when the Library Board has \$1.4 million in the bank. He wished the mothers out there a Happy Mother's Day.

Councilman Vuoncino welcomed our new Police Officer and announced the upcoming Click it or Ticket campaign. He discussed the new traffic light on Broadway near the Broadway train station. He is pleased and it is exactly what is needed down there. He announced the Volunteer Ambulance Corps. car show.

Councilman Martino congratulated Office Yates. He announced the next Homeowner's Association meeting. He wished everyone a Happy Mother's Day.

Councilman Pettigano reported on the registrations for soccer. He announced the basketball awards dinner and the playoff schedule. The Councilman announced Community Day. He stated the Elmwood Park Alumni Association decorated the island on Lincoln Avenue with the help of Durante Construction. He thanked all involved.

Councilman Colletti reported that the purchase for the Fire Department was funded through Fire Prevention fees and violations, with no effect on the taxpayer. He asked residents to support the EPFD and the VAC financially. He asked residents to consider joining the Fire Department.

Mayor Mola announced a meeting between the Recreation Director and Board of Education on programming and the tennis court improvements. The Mayor discussed the history of how paving under Route 80 by the NJ DOT came to be. He also discussed the instillation of the new traffic signals on Broadway and the history pertaining to that project and how it came to fruition. He thanked all those involved including DOT Commissioner Fox. The Mayor thanked Congressman Pascrell for his work in improving the Midland Avenue train crossing. He stated he is still working on the sound barriers and the music coming from Eastside Park. He discussed the Community Development funding we have been slated to receive and why it may be less than originally thought. The Mayor also discussed music coming from Eastside Park in Paterson and how the EPPD is working with the Paterson Police.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

James D'Amico, Willow Street, encouraged residents to attend the Homeowner's Association meetings. Mr. D'Amico discussed what is happening at the Board of Education with capital reserve funds. He stated the Board of Education adopted their budget by 2% and discussed the \$1.4 million surplus. Last year's surplus was over \$2 million. These funds are going into capital reserves. Mr. D'Amico discussed the Board of Education raising taxes by 2% even with the surplus in place. He further talked about the new football field, and the prior votes rejecting the field improvements. He stated school taxes are increasing and the surplus is being used to renovate the football field even after the voters voted no twice. Mr. D'Amico stated he will not back down on this issue and is looking to build support.

Robert Colon, Parkview Avenue, thanked Council President Dombrowski for his honesty relative to the library. Mr. Colon stated he attended the Library Board meeting and doesn't support expanding the library. He believes we should improve and clean the library, but there is no need for expansion. He discussed the funds available in the Library Board capital fund. Mr. Colon asked why the Mayor and Council do not have input into what happens with the library. Mayor Mola discussed some of the improvements that have been made and are being discussed. Mr. Colon stated that information is available now on phones and other devices. He does not what the library to go away, but we need prioritize what needs to be done.

Steve Conte, Market Street, asked whether the apartments can rent garages to non-tenants. It will be hard to remove cars from the streets when they are renting garages to people outside the complex. Mr. Conte stated he feels the Police Department should not drop below 40 officers. He discussed the Parkview Auto operating illegally. Mayor Mola asked the Clerk to bring it to the attention of the Building Department. Mr. Conte discussed handicap accessibility at the library and that area being in disrepair. He discussed government working too slowly. Mr. Conte discussed that he was on the Library Board years ago. He questioned whether all the Library Board members and the Board of Health members live in town. He stated he was told he needed to come off the Library Board and was never told that a member can be from out of town as we have now. He discussed things needing to get repaired quickly and sited examples of what need to be addressed in a timely fashion. Mr. Conte stated he does not feel that the library needs to be expanded. He cited examples of what improvement should be made. He discussed the rankings of towns in New Jersey and where Elmwood Park fell in this listing. The Mayor stated that he questioned the criteria and how they put that listing together. Mr. Conte asked about the pump station and how it will be improved. Council President Dombrowski and Councilman Colletti responded that it will be re-built from the inside, but the building will remain. Mr. Conte asked whether a proposal was considered to rebuild the entire station. Council President Dombrowski stated that both Boswell Engineering and Aliamo Engineering agreed this was the way to pursue the project. Discussion as to cost ensued. Mr. Conte expressed the need for the Borough and property owners to maintain their properties. He discussed the need for changes to parking in town and specifically was asked by the Mayor about Market Street. Mr. Conte stated the town should consider angle parking. Discussion about parking and resident parking ensued. He encouraged the Council to make decisions and just not sit on their hands.

Richard Trawinski, Walnut Street stated he was taken back by the apartments renting garages to contractors and others. He discussed the pump station and feels that it should be rebuilt rather than remodeled, because of the cost to bypass it during construction. Mr. Trawinski stated that he supports the library and is favor of the library; however he does not support an expansion. He stated the skylights need to be replaced and the building needs to be remodeled. He also discussed some of the capital funds being saved and some returned to the taxpayers. Mr. Trawinski stated that he was against the parking lot being paved for \$65,000 as part of the road program when the Library Board had \$1.4 million in the bank. He discussed the hiring of an architect and the previous lack of a capital plan. Mr. Trawinski also feels the Council should play a role in deciding what gets done at the library.

Karen Varrecchia, Lee Street stated that the children's room in the library is dirty and a disgrace. She explained that there are wires exposed, it is filthy and the fountain does not work. She asked who maintains the library. Mayor Mola stated the Library Board and encouraged Ms. Varrecchia to attend more meetings. She then explained some of the addition issues she observed while attending a meeting at the library. She also stated that she does not support an expansion, but feels the building needs to be improved. Ms. Varrecchia asked about three Library Board members being enough to award contracts. She further explained that members of the Board only received a 23 page document to award this the day before. She expressed concern about seniors and children using the library.

Mayor Mola discussed the Library Board's efforts to build a new children's room and make the current room a computer room. He further said that the other political parties in town are now all against the library expansion.

Mr. Colon again approached the microphone and took exception to the political parties being mentioned and discussed some additional concerns he has with the library. He also took exception to it being stated that he is against the library. The Mayor stated that he previously stated that he was against the expansion.
