BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ORDINANCE 15-02

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 3-28 TO THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ENTITLED "CURFEW."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: The Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall entitled is hereby amended by the following

Chapter 3-28 CURFEW

ARTICLE I Halloween Curfew for Minors

§ 28-1.	Short title.
§ 28-2.	Definitions and word usage.
§ 28-3.	Curfew for minors.
§ 28-4.	Exceptions.
§ 28-5.	Parental responsibility.
§ 28-6.	Police procedures.
§ 28-7.	Violations and penalties.

ARTICLE I Halloween Curfew for Minors

§ 28-1. Short title.

This article shall be known and may be referred to as the "Curfew Ordinance."

§ 28-2. Definitions and word usage.

For the purpose of this article, the following terms, phases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings herein. Where not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words in the plural number include the singular, and words in the singular number include the plural. The word "shall" is mandatory and not merely directive.

MINOR — Any person under the age of 18 years.

PARENT — Any person having custody of a minor:

- A. As a natural or adoptive parent;
- B. As a legal guardian;
- C. As a person who stands in loco parentis; or
- D. As a person to whom physical custody has been given by order of court.

REMAIN — To stay behind, to tarry and to stay unnecessarily upon the streets in which any minor involved would not be using the streets for ordinary or serious purposes such as mere passage or going home.

STREET — A way or place, of whatsoever nature, open to the use of the public as a matter of right for purposes of vehicular travel, or in the case of a sidewalk thereof, for pedestrian travel. The term "street" includes the legal right-of-way, including but not limited to the cartway of traffic lanes, the curb, the sidewalks, whether paved or unpaved, and any grass plots or the grounds found within the

legal right-of-way of a street. The term "street" applies irrespective of what it is called or formally named, whether alley, avenue, court, road or otherwise.

TIME OF NIGHT — Referred to herein is based upon Eastern standard time.

BOROUGH — The Borough of Elmwood Park, Bergen County, New Jersey, with administrative offices at 182 Market Street, Elmwood Park, New Jersey.

YEAR OF AGE — Continues from one birthday, such as the 17th, to (but not including the day of) the next, such as the 18th birthday, making it clear that 17 or fewer years of age is herein treated as equivalent to the phrase "under 18 years of age."

§ 28-3. Curfew for minors.

It shall be unlawful for any minor to be or remain in or upon any street, alley, highway, road, park, playground, dock or other public ground or public place, place of amusement, entertainment, vacant lot or other public place within the confines of the Borough each year during the following periods of time: 9:00 p.m. October 30th through 6:00 a.m. October 31st; 9:00 p.m. October 31st through 6:00 a.m. November 1st.

§ 28-4. Exceptions.

In the following exceptional cases, a minor on the Borough streets during the hours set forth above shall not be considered in violation of this article:

- A. When accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or other adult having the care, custody and control of the minor;
- B. When accompanied by an adult authorized by a parent of such minor to take said parent's place in accompanying said minor;
- C. When exercising rights protected by the United States Constitution or its Amendments, such as the free exercise of religion, freedom of speech and the right of assembly. The minor shall first deliver to the Police Department at the Borough Municipal Building, at 182 Market Street, a letter signed by such minor and countersigned by a parent of such minor stating their home address, telephone number and specifying where and in what manner the minor will be on the streets during hours when this article is otherwise applicable;
- D. In the case of reasonable necessity as determined by the Chief of Police or his designee, but only after such minor's parent has written to the Borough Police Department stating their name, address, telephone number and the facts establishing such reasonable necessity and specifying the streets and times for the described purpose, including points of origin and destination;
- E. When the minor is directly in front of the place where such minor resides or directly in front of either next door neighbor, if this neighbor does not object to the minor's presence;
- F. When proceeding by a direct route to or from home, work, a school activity, or an activity of religious or other voluntary association, provided that it is within 1/2 hour of the start or end of the work or activity;
- G. When authorized by the Chief of Police or his designee when necessary nighttime activities of a minor may be inadequately provided for by other provisions of this article;
- H. When the minor is in a motor vehicle engaged in normal travel and with parent's consent, or if the minor is engaged in interstate travel.

§ 28-5. Parental responsibility.

It shall be unlawful for any person, parent or guardian having the legal care or custody of a minor knowingly to permit or, by inefficient control, to allow such minor to be or remain upon any Borough street in violation of this article. The term "knowingly" includes knowledge which a parent should reasonably be expected to have concerning the whereabouts of a minor in that parent's custody.

§ 28-6. Police procedures.

A. A police officer of the Borough upon finding or having attention called to any minor on the streets shall take action pursuant to the Borough of Elmwood Park Guidelines/State of New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines.

§ 28-7. Violations and penalties.

Penalties for a violation of this article shall be the following: a fine up to \$1,000 and community service for any adult or juvenile found in violation. If both the juvenile and the juvenile's parent or guardian violate this article, they may be required to perform community service together.

§ 28-8. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ORDINANCE NO.: 15-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, TO FIX THE RATES AND PRICES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER AND ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION, SUPPLY, USE AND PROTECTION OF SAID WATER AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF CERTAIN SAID RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, due to a aggregate 4 % increase in water consumption from bulk water supplier, Passaic Valley Water Commission, the following is necessary;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1 A fixed charge known as "the service charge," will be made to each Consumer for each meter based on the size of the meter or connection regardless of the amount of water consumed as follows:

5/8 in. Meter (average 1 and 2 family homes)	\$42.59
¾ in. Meter	\$47.90
1 in. Meter	\$51.10
1½ in. Meter	\$55.35
2 in. Meter	\$56.42
3 in. Meter	\$80.84
4 in. Meter	\$95.72
6 in. Meter	\$123.34
Flush tank connection	\$39.38

Section 2: The following water rates and changes are hereby established for water supplied by the Department.

The minimum quarterly bill for metered service shall be "the service charge" entitling the consumer to 5,000 gallons of water per quarter. All water supplied through meters in excess of the minimum quarterly bill, shall be charged to each consumer at the rate of:

\$4.70 per 1,000 gallons over 5,000 gallons

\$5.10 per 1,000 gallons over 70,000 gallons

\$5.79 per 1,000 gallons over 150,000 gallons

\$6.21 per 1,000 gallons over 300,000 gallons

3 in. Service	\$170.32
4 in. Service	\$265.71
6 in. Service	\$487.13
8 in. Service	\$765.05
10 in. Service	\$953.80
12 in. Service	\$1277.42

The above schedule for stand by fire line and/or sprinkler connections shall be quarterly charges upon presentation of proper bills from the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 3:

The following are hereby established as charges for the installation, repair, replacement and other charges in connection with the operation of the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

Installation, replacement, and repair of existing meters shall be charged at actual current cost for labor and material incurred by the Water Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park and/or Passaic Valley Water Commission.

F. All commercial users having meters in excess of ¾" must have them in working order at all times. In the event said meter is inoperative, and no attempt is made for repair/replacement of same, the existing estimated bill shall be tripled the existing estimated rate, upon the effective date of this ordinance. In the event no meter in excess of 3/4" exist, in addition to the tripled estimated bill, the landlord shall be required to purchase and install same upon written order of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 4: "In the event that payment for water charges is in arrears for 30 days from date of billing, the Borough shall send a delinquent notice regular mail, to the owner, occupier, user or responsible party being billed. After 60 days, a door tag shall be hand delivered to terminate water service. On the 67th day of non payment from date of billing, water service will be terminated, and not reinstated until all fees, penalties, are paid in full in cash.

\$137.13 turn on fee, is made to the Borough of Elmwood Park.

Section 4b: "In the event, that water charges are in the arrears, after 60 days, a door tag will be delivered to terminate water service and a fee of \$40.00 will be assessed on to the delinquent water bill.

Section 5: All unpaid water charges as of 12/31 of the present year shall become a Tax Lien on said premises.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

Section 7: All billings as of March 1, 2015 and thereafter will be subject to said rate.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Caramagna discussed the departure of Dr. Tomko from the School District. He congratulated the students on their achievements during the fall sports season at the High School. He stated there was also discussion at the Board of Education meeting regarding the costs for Boswell Engineering regarding the proposed football field.

Councilman Dombrowski congratulated Michael Dare on his signing with Rutgers University. He discussed the past snow storms the Borough experienced. He encouraged residents to place garbage cans on the sidewalk so that they do not hinder the plowing of the streets. He also addressed the amount of tickets that have been issued for not obeying the snow parking laws.

Councilman Vuoncino acknowledged two officers who responded to a home where it was reported by a family member who lives out of state that an elderly relative had fallen. He reiterated on the need for residents to obey the parking rules when the Borough experiences snow storms. He also congratulated Michael Dare on his achievement.

Councilman Martino mentioned an upcoming meeting of the Homeowners Association.

Councilman Pettigano discussed the snow parking rules and stated the roads being cleared are extremely important for all the Borough's emergency services. He asked to check on elderly neighbors and generators in cold & snow weather. He also congratulated Michael Dare.

Councilman Colletti discussed the Fire Department's Installation Dinner. He discussed the importance of clearing the snow around fire hydrants. He acknowledged the disappointment residents feel when a recently cleared hydrant becomes covered again when a plow goes by. He stated when clearing the fire hydrant by his house, he waits until he believes the plows have completed their job. He stated the Fire Department is seeking new recruits.

Councilman Caramagna discussed the problem when residents throw snow out into the roadway.

Borough Attorney Randazzo reported progress.

Mayor Mola discussed the snow parking regulations. He discussed going to a Freeholder meeting in January where he expressed the Borough's desire to complete the County Park near Artesian Fields. He discussed a meeting with Commissioner Fox from the Department of Transportation. He stated a traffic light will be placed by the Fair Lawn Train Station on Broadway by the end of April. Commissioner Fox also said in the spring the roadway on Market Street and River Drive under the Route 80 overpasses will be paved. Mayor Mola stated he is looking for more residents that would like to be a part of the 100th Anniversary Committee.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Doreen Aspras, Van Riper Avenue, inquired about the process and the funds used by the Borough when purchasing new police cars.

James Damico, Willow Street, stated that at a recent Board of Education meeting, Board members questioned why no one ever questions the Council as to how they spend money. He also stated some of the members of the Board are trying to put blame on the Council for certain items. Mr. Damico also discussed how his family handles the parking during snow storms.

Gladys Gryskiewicz, Fenscak Avenue, discussed the children having to walk in the streets to get to school or home because sidewalks are not being cleared. She stated everyone needs to put their heads together to come up with a solution.

Jeff Frietag, Hillman Drive, clarified some earlier statements made regarding comments at the Board of Education meeting regarding the purchase of Police cars. The comment was made by only one board member and not the Board as a whole. He signage.

Kenneth Arabia, Locust Street, discussed drivers not stopping at the stop sign at the end of Locust Street. He also stated he saw office furniture being thrown out which he said was good furniture. He also stated he sees Police Officers talking on their cell phones while they are driving. He further mentioned that Police Officers are no longer parking in the parking lot and watching for drivers that do not stop at the stop sign at the end of Locust. He stated the tank has been in the same place since the 70s, and if it gets

moved it might fall apart. He also stated it is not worth \$50,000 to refurbish the tank. He stated the storm drains need to be cleaned.

Jean Frietag, Hillman Drive, followed up on Councilman Caramagna's comment regarding the departure of Dr. Tomko. She stated that Anthony Greico will be the Acting Superintendant and further stated other changes in the administration due to the departure of Dr. Tomko.

James Damico, Willow Street, inquired about the process when a Board of Education's budget is defeated. Borough Clerk Keith Kazmark explained when the Board of Education voted to move their election to November, they also agreed to keep their budget increases under 2%. Therefore, the school budget no longer goes to the voters for approval and removes the Council's responsibility for the school budget should it fail. Mr. Damico also apologized to the Board members that were present that the comments made earlier by him were stated by one member of the Board of Education.

Richard Trawinski, Walnut Street, stated that one member of the Board of Education was blaming the School District budget deficit on past years when the budgets were defeated and the Council needed to make cuts. He stated he saw many children walking on River Drive because the sidewalks were not shoveled. He stated that violations should be given to the responsible party for areas of sidewalks that have not been shoveled.

William Meneely, Washington Avenue, inquired if the savings for 2014 by switching from Boswell Engineering to Alaimo Group is known. He discussed the congestion at 16th Avenue School during drop exasperates the problem. He further suggested what other towns do around their schools.

A motion was made by Councilman Colletti and seconded by Councilman Dombrowski to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
