BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ORDINANCE 16-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Chapter II thereof, entitled "Administration".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter II of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, entitled "Administration" is hereby amended, and specifically Ordinance 2-27.1, titled "Creation of the Department; Members" by deleting the existing section and replacing it with the following:

2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members.

- a. There are hereby created the following positions in the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:
 - 1. One (1) Chief of Police;
 - 2. Two (2) Captains;
 - 3. Two (4) Lieutenants;
 - 4. Four (4) Sergeants.
 - 5. A maximum of thirty-one (29) Patrolmen.
- b. In order to provide for a safe and efficient transition when a member or members of the police force give notice of their intent to retire/resign, there shall be permitted a maximum of two additional Patrolmen (in addition to the number of Patrolmen set forth in a. 5 above) who may be employed for a maximum of six months for the purpose of training and familiarization with police procedures.

Notwithstanding the limitations set forth above, no officer who is currently employed by the Borough shall be removed from his position or reduced in rank as a result of this Table of Organization.

<u>Section 2.</u> If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Martino commented on the Welcome to Elmwood Park signage. He stated baseball signups are ongoing. He stated two local deli establishments sold \$50,000 winning tickets in the recent power ball drawing.

Councilman Chirdo congratulated all the children who received soccer awards tonight. He discussed looking forward to working with the Department of Public Works as their liaison. He also commented on the town welcome signs.

Council President Vuoncino congratulated the soccer teams on their accomplishments. He discussed the result of the SEM auctions. He then discussed his reason for voting no on tonight's appointment to the Recreation Advisory Board. He attributed his decision to Mr. Pettigano's part in spearheading the change from the Recreation Commission to an advisory board. Council President Vuoncino discussed the inability to schedule a meeting with the Library Board. He feels that a stop work order should be issued to the architect until questions are answered. He discussed the ordinance pertaining to the improvements to Borough owned buildings and the Mayor's veto which was submitted on December 31, 2015.

Councilman Dombrowski congratulated the soccer teams. He also thanked all the coaches and parents for their dedication. He discussed the licensing of cats and dogs and the rabies vaccine requirements which need to be met in order to license pets. He then discussed the Board of Health entering into a 5 year Shared Service Agreement with the County Health Department. Councilman Dombrowski discussed upcoming Project Graduation events. He then discussed an upcoming event sponsored by the Homeowners Association where Police Chief Foligno will be a guest speaker. Councilman Dombrowski discussed an upcoming Library Board meeting with the architect. He encouraged the public to attend the meeting.

Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed attending a meeting for newly elected officials. She then discussed attending a Centennial event at Blue 42 Restaurant and Bar. She stated he had a meeting with the Borough's CFO Roy Riggitano. Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed a volunteer form that is available on the Borough's website. She concluded that she looks forward to working with everyone.

Mayor Mola appointed Jamie Silverman as the Mayor's Delegate for the Library Board. He discussed a letter of resignation of Eugene Leon from the Planning Board. He stated he wishes to fill the vacancy with Joseph Abramo who is an alternate.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Richard Trawinski, Walnut Street, inquired about the appointment to the Library Board. He questioned whether a second motion was made to appoint Kathleen Policano. He further questioned about the 30 day hold on the appointment. Borough Attorney Giblin stated that Mayor Mola has 30 days to make as many nominations as he wishes and after 30 days the Council can then appointment someone of their choice to the vacancy. Deputy Borough Clerk Barbara Dispoto confirmed that Councilman Chirdo seconded the motion to appoint Kathleen Policano.

Richard DeLorenzo, Hillman Drive, also member of the Recreation Advisory Board, wished everyone a Happy New Year to the new Councilmembers. Mr. DeLorenzo expressed his disappointment in the appointment of Glen Pettigano to the Recreation Advisory Board. He stated he respects those who spoke out against the appointment. He then discussed the article in the Community News regarding the vacant seat on the Recreation Advisory Board and the comments made by Councilman Colletti. Councilman Colletti responded to Mr. DeLorenzo's comments. Mr. DeLorenzo stated there should have been a better candidate nominated for the seat. Councilman Colletti discussed how he came to vote the way he did. Mr. DeLorenzo discussed other Board members and the connection they have with other sport organizations and Borough Hall. He closed by saying anyone who voted yes should be ashamed of themselves.

James Damico, Willow Street, discussed a resident that was struck by a car Monday night and is in critical condition. He stated he is shocked at the appointment of Mr. Pettigano. He further

stated that as liaison to the Recreation Advisory Board, Mr. Pettigano missed 40% of Recreation Meetings and questioned if he will be able to make future meetings.

Kenneth Arabia, Locust Street, offered his 10 minutes of public comment to Tom Conboy.

Tom Conboy, Tuella Avenue, stated that Roberts Rule of Order allow one member of the public to offer their public comment time to another public member. Mr. Conboy then stated the Borough Attorney should weigh in. Borough Attorney Giblin addressed Mr. Conboy's statement regarding Roberts Rules of Order. Mr. Conboy then discussed the Mayor's veto. He discussed the prior month's Library Board meeting in which discussion took place regarding unspent funds for 2015 and how funds were not spent to make much needed repairs to the building. He then discussed the handling of committee meetings with the Library Board. Mr. Conboy then discussed the appointment of Mr. Pettigano to the Recreation Advisory Board. He further discussed comments made by Mr. Pettigano in the past regarding Cherry Hill Park and voting against grant money for the parks.

Mayor Mola closed the public portion. A motion was made by Councilman and seconded by Councilman to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
