ORDINANCE # 21-06**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A “ONE STOP” AT FLORENCE PLACE AND ST. ANNE STREET AND TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "TRAFFIC" MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 7-20 TITLED “STOP INTERSECTIONS”

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular intersection of Florence Place and St. Anne Street for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey the Mayor and Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a “One Stop” at Florence Place and St. Anne Street in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated “One Stop” is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary “One Stop” signs at the above-mentioned intersection on St. Anne right side of the intersection.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-20 titled “Stop Intersections” is hereby amended so as to include thereto the “One Stop” at Florence Place and St. Anne Street as follows:

Is hereby amended to include the “One Stop” intersection of Florence Place and St. Anne Street. That traffic will stop in the direction of St. Anne Street to Florence Place.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance with the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 6: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: Repealer. All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: Effective Date.: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provide by law.

**APPOINTMENT OF RISK MANAGER
SCIROCCO GROUP**

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Borough of Elmwood Park to retain the services of a professional risk management consultant for those insurance matters (property & casualty, worked compensation, property, excess liability, public officials' liability, environmental liability) integral to the operation of the Borough for the calendar year 2021; and

WHEREAS, such services are highly specialized in nature and exempt from a formal bidding pursuant to the New Jersey Public Contract Laws, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1); and

WHEREAS, the Borough, notwithstanding that this particular service may be exempt from the formal bidding process pursuant to the New Jersey Public Contract Laws, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1), caused a request for qualifications and proposal for the services of a risk management professional was posted on December 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, only two bidders submitted proposals, same being Professional Insurance Associates, Inc. and Scirocco Group, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, at the public meeting of February 18, 2021, where the appointment of a risk manager was to be considered and a resolution had been prepared for the appointment of Professional Insurance Associates, the Borough Council defeated the resolution by a majority vote, thereby denying the re-appointment of Professional Insurance Associates, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, by verbal motion and second, and by a vote of the majority of the Council, the Scirocco Group, the alternate bidder, was approved to replace the existing risk management professional; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council by majority vote, voted to appoint the Scirocco Group, Inc. as the risk management professional for the Borough of Elmwood Park, requiring that a new resolution be prepared to memorialize the verbal voted resolution of the February 18, 2021 vote; and

WHEREAS, the contract amount for these services shall be no more than 6% of the Borough's annual JIF Assessment, payable by the South Bergen Joint Insurance Fund directly to Scirocco Group, Inc; and

WHEREAS, said contract, in aggregate, is above \$17,500 as certified by the Borough Chief Financial Officer and therefore, such award be in compliance with the requirement set forth by P.L. 2004, Chapter 19 (as amended by P.L. 2005,c. 51) N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Council believe it is in the best interest of the Borough to appoint Scirocco Group, Inc. as the Borough's risk management consultant for 2021; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the majority of the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that Scirocco Group, Inc. is hereby appointed as Risk Management Consultant for the year of 2021 and that Mayor Robert Colletti and Borough Clerk Erin Delaney are hereby authorized to execute the risk management consultant's agreement in accordance with the by-laws of the South Bergen Municipal Joint Insurance Fund for the period ending December 31, 2021, or until a successor shall have qualified; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be provided to Scirocco Group, Inc., the Borough Chief Financial Officer, and Borough Auditor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a notice of said contract award, stating the nature, duration and services provided, be published in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1).

Following the reading of the Consent Agenda, Mayor Colletti asked for the following to be read into the record on his behalf:

“Regarding R-109-21 appointment of Risk Manager, I find the decision to remove the PIA Group managed by Frank Covelli appalling and disgusting and wrecks with a foul smell of politics. PIA Group that has represented Elmwood Park for approximately 21 years as our risk manager has saved us hundreds of thousands of dollars along with a stellar performance of service. Our administrators who work with these professionals on a daily basis advised the Council they were completely satisfied with Frank Covelli’s performance and did not want a change. Oblivious to their concerns the council members, not all, and I repeat not all voted by a slim margin with one abstention to remove PIA Group and replace. What we have here is a classic case of outside political forces dismantling a solid core of professional that we have in place to further their own political agendas. Subsequently, if we allow this to happen the results will be a weak foundation that will stifle the progressive movement that is now in motion to revitalize our beloved Elmwood Park. Let us lead with our hearts not our politics.”

Council President Wechtler stated that she agrees with the Mayor that political was involved. She felt that they should remain as only one error was made and PIA has always been there for the Borough.

Councilman Golabek specified that PIA was not removed and, rather, did not have enough votes for their reappointment. He also noted that this did not come out of left field as it was discussed for months. Councilman Golabek said that the employees will not see a change and they have a responsibility on the council to bring in solutions and other options.

Mayor Colletti then said that Councilman Golabek brought in the new risk manager group in the early discussion phase and, therefore, he felt it was premeditated to replace PIA. He declared that PIA had one blemish which was resolved.

Councilwoman Pellegrine advised that she will be voting no on the replacement being that PIA has provided over 20 years of great services to the Borough and, although they made a mistake, they have always been there for the Borough.

Councilwoman Balistreri stated that the issue was discussed for months and that members of the Governing Body need to respect each other’s’ votes.

Councilman Fasolo said that he will be voting in favor of the replacement as he feels it was a big mistake that was made.

Councilman Golabek stated that he had no comments.

Councilwoman Pellegrine shared that the RAP Program held a food drive and thanked the donors and volunteers. She also announcing that the Community Policing division is working to establish a club in the high school.

Council President Wechtler advised that she visited the library and the new renovations look great. She stated that public service is due to begin their work in a week’s time and, once complete, the library will finally be turned over to the trustees. Council President Wechtler then announced that the Homeowner’s Association will begin their meetings again in September and shared information regarding the next bus trip.

Councilwoman Balistreri reminded the public about the upcoming Easter Egg Hunt and noted that the April minicamp registration is now open. She also shared that she is happy the sports stipend program is back in place and concluded her report by commending the new Recreation Director.

Mayor Colletti extended his gratitude to Borough’s electrical inspector who helped expedite the process of getting public service in to the library to finish the work.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Doreen Frega, Saddle Brook, shared information, on behalf of the Animal Protection League of New Jersey, on non-lethal alternatives for geese management. She provided Borough Administrator Foligno a folder of information for review.

Jeffrey Freitag, Hillman Drive, inquired about the opening of the Recreation Center. He then questioned whether or not the payment regarding Tuella Avenue was the final payment for the project. Lastly, Mr. Freitag requested more information on the Honda payment on the Bills List.
