CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF \$210,000 FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE WATER TANK IN, BY AND FOR THE WATER UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH ADDITIONAL SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM WATER UTILITY CAPITAL FUND BALANCE OF THE BOROUGH

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), has heretofore authorized the replacement of the Water Tank (located at Gilbert Avenue and East 54th Street) in, by and for the Water Utility of the Borough and appropriated the sum of \$2,330,000 therefor pursuant to Ordinance No. 17-35 adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough on December 21, 2017 (the "Prior Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council now finds and determines that the additional sum of \$210,000 is required for such improvement and that such sum is available in Water Utility Capital Fund Balance of the Borough to pay the additional cost of such improvement, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows

Section 1. The additional sum of \$210,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the replacement of the Water Tank authorized in the Prior Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from Water Utility Capital Fund Balance of the Borough, as hereinafter provided. The sum of \$210,000 is hereby appropriated from Water Utility Capital Fund Balance of the Borough to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 2. Said improvement is a lawful capital improvement of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvement has been and shall be made as a general improvement, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE REPLACEMENT OF WATER LINES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE WATER UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$270,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to replace water lines at various locations in, by and for the Water Utility of the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.
- Section 2. The sum of \$270,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required for this bond ordinance pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) and 40A:2-7(h). Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.
- Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$270,000, and (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$270,000, and (5) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$20,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.
- Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that the Water Utility would have been self-liquidating, as defined in Section 47(a) of the Local Bond Law, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017, had there been included in the interest and debt redemption charges for such year an amount equal to interest for one year at the rate of four and one half percentum (4½%) per annum on said bonds or notes, and the amount of the first installment of serial bonds legally issuable to finance such purpose plus an amount for charges as aforesaid with respect to all bonds and notes authorized but not issued for such Water Utility.
- Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$270,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.
- Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$270,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Chapter 27, Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Solid Waste Management" by adding 27-5 et al..

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 27 titled "Solid Waste Management" is hereby amended by adding Section 5 as follows:

27-5.1 No trash pickup shall occur in the Borough prior to 7 a.m and no later than 7 p.m. wherein the trash container/dumpster is of a size and/or weight that the trash collector cannot manually lift the container and is required to pick up/lift the container by use of the hydraulics, forks, front end lift, cable lift etc. on the garbage truck.

Section 2.

WHEREAS, as part of the settlement the Governing Body has agreed to rezoning Lot 2.01 in Block 1201 with a street address of 778 River Drive to accommodate a mixed-use development with an affordable housing component; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that amendments herein to the Zoning and Site Plan Review Regulations of the Borough of Elmwood Park are in the best interests of the citizens of the Borough of Elmwood Park;

NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that the Zoning and Site Plan Review Regulations of the Borough of Elmwood Park be amended as follows:

SECTION 1

Section 34-5 concerning the establishment of districts shall be amended to read as follows:

34-5 ESTABLISHMENT OF DISTRICTS.

34-5.1 Division into Districts.

The Borough of Elmwood Park, New Jersey is hereby divided into seventeen (17) zoning districts to be designated as follows:

The official Zoning Map as referenced in Section 34-5.2 shall be amended to show Lot 2.01 in Block 1201 as in a new AH-3 Zone and a new subparagraph 9 shall be added to Section 34-5.2. b. referencing this Zoning Map amended to read as follows:

34-5.2 Zoning District Map.

- b. Amendments to zoning district boundaries shall be entered on said map and a record of such amendments noted therein.
 - Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2018- 1 , the Zoning Map is revised to depict Lot 2.01 in Block 1201 as within the AH-3 Affordable Housing Zone.

SECTION 3

A new Section 34-13.1 shall be added to read as follows:

34-13 AH-3 AFFORDABLE HOUSING DISTRICT

34-13.1 Purpose.

The purpose of this district is to encourage the development of multi-family housing that would include rental units for low and moderate-income households in the amount of fifteen (15%) percent of the total number of dwelling units and to allow in residential buildings certain nonresidential uses.

34-13.2 Permitted Uses.

The following uses are permitted in the AH-3 Affordable Housing District:

a. Principal Permitted Uses.

Multi-family housing including both age-restricted non-age-restricted units at a maximum density of thirty-five (35) dwelling units per acre, but not to exceed 390 dwelling units in the AH-3 Zone. Age-restricted buildings shall contain dwelling units where the head of household is at least 55 years of age in accordance with federal law.

Commercial uses in residential buildings as permitted in the C-L Local Commerce Zone except that drive-in restaurants shall not be permitted and that gymnasiums, health clubs, swim clubs, tennis clubs and hotels shall be permitted.

Community or assembly rooms for senior citizens in an age-restricted building that shall be available for use by the general public subject to reasonable restrictions established by the property owner.

Hotel uses.

Assisted living facilities.

b. Accessory Uses.

Uses and structures customarily incidental to principal permitted uses in the AH-3 Zone including but not limited to driveways, parking areas, signs, community rooms, and active and passive recreational facilities.

34-13.3 Area and Bulk Tract Regulations.

The following area and bulk regulations apply to the entire AH-3 Zone as one development entity. Lands in the AH-3 Zone may be subdivided into individual lots encompassing buildings or use areas for the purposes of phasing, ownership, financing or related issues in which case the Tract Regulations shall not apply to individual lots within the AH-3 Zone.

34.13.4 Additional Regulations.

The following additional regulations shall apply in the AH-3 Zone:

- a. Fifteen (15%) of the dwelling units in the AH-3 Zone shall be dedicated for rental occupancy by low and moderate-income households. Such units shall be deed-restricted for a period of at least 30 years and shall comply with Uniform Housing Affordability Controls (N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.1 et seq.) or any successor regulation with respect to bedroom distribution, income distribution, pricing requirements, affirmative marketing, candidate qualifications and screening and any other requirement necessary to assure that such affordable units count for the Borough of Elmwood Park's affordable housing obligation, with the exception that in lieu of ten (10%) percent of affordable units in rental projects being required to be at 35% of median income, 13 percent of affordable units shall be at thirty (30%) percent of medium income.
- b. The provisions of Section 34-21 concerning multiple dwellings and townhouses shall not be applicable to the AH-3 Zone.
- c. Required parking for dwelling units shall be 1.75 spaces per unit and required parking for nonresidential uses shall be one (1) space for each three hundred (300) square feet of leasable floor area.
- d. Wall-mounted signs for nonresidential tenants shall be permitted up to a maximum of two (2) square feet for each foot of length of exterior building wall facing a street.
- e. Development in the AH-3 Zone shall adhere to the following limitations and shall be phased in accordance with the following standards:
 - Development in the AH-3 Zone shall consist of a maximum of four principal buildings referenced as Buildings A, B, C and D and a riverfront walkway.
 - (2) Building A shall be a maximum of four (4) stories and consist of a maximum of 128 dwelling units, six (6) units of which shall be affordable units.
 - (3) Building B shall be an age-restricted building with a maximum of four (4) stories, a maximum of 54 dwelling units, 22 units of which shall be age-restricted affordable units, shall contain a community room that is available for use by the general public, and may contain a maximum of 25,000 square feet of leasable area of nonresidential tenant space (A minimum of 10,000 sf is required in either Building C or Building B but not both).

- (4) Building C shall be a maximum of five (5) stories and consist of a maximum of 112 dwelling units, 22 of which shall be affordable units and may contain a maximum of 25,000 square feet of leasable area of nonresidential tenant space (A minimum of 10,000 sf is required in either Building C or Building B but not both).
- (5) Building D shall be a maximum of four (4) stories and consist of a maximum of 96 dwelling units, nine (9) units of which shall be affordable units.

SECTION 4

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to said inconsistencies and conflicts.



AN ORDINANCE TO ADDRESS THE ISSUE OF CROWD CONTROL WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK

1. Outdoor Event

In an effort to maintain crowd control within the Borough, the Borough intends to regulate certain outdoor events. An "outdoor event" under this ordinance shall mean any event that: 1) anticipates attendance of 75 or more persons; and 2) occurs on either private or public property.

2. Location of Outdoor Event

An "outdoor event" under this ordinance may only occur in the following zoning districts within the Borough:

R-3	Low/Medium Density Housing
R-5	Low/Medium Density Housing
R-9	Medium Density Housing
R-18	Medium/High Density Housing
R-MF	Multi-Family Housing
C-L	Local Commerce
C-G	General Commerce
C-O	Office
N-C	Neighborhood Commercial (Ord. No. 2015-13)
I-R	Restricted Industrial
I-G	General Industrial
POP	Planned Office Park
ARHO	Age Restricted Housing Overlay
AH-1	Affordable Housing-1
AH-2	Affordable Housing-2
AEO	Adult Entertainment Overlay

3. Application

The organizer of any outdoor event under this ordinance is required to obtain an application from the Borough at least 30 days in advance of the event. The application must include the nature of the event, the location, the start and end times of the event, identification and contact information of a responsible party or organizer, and a site diagram which depicts the entire area in which persons will be attending the event.

4. Proof of Insurance

An applicant must obtain general liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000.00 before the Borough will approve an application under this ordnance. The policy must name the Borough as an additional insured.

5. Fees

An application fee of \$250.00 will be assessed for any applications filed under this ordinance. The application fee will be waived for Borough sponsored events and certified non-profit organizations.

6. Approving Authority

All applications under this ordinance shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk and reviewed by the Elmwood Park Police Department, the Fire Department, Code Enforcement officials, and, if necessary, the Board of Health. The Mayor and Borough Council will have final approval on all applications issued under this ordinance, which will be granted by vote via Resolution.

7. Penalty

Any person who violates this provision shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 for each separate offense and/or confinement in the Passaic County Jail for a period of not more than 90 days. In addition, the applicant is responsible for all "emergent costs" incurred as a direct result of the scheduled event.

- 3. All staff that are provided by the Borough for this program agree to provide the necessary supervision and administration inherent in providing this program. Prior to the commencement of employment, all staff will submit to a criminal background check/fingerprinting either at their own expense or at the expense of the Borough, the results of which shall be provided upon request of the Board.
- 4. The Borough shall operate the program in compliance with all State laws and codes. Staff to include child ratios shall meet New Jersey licensing requirements.
- 5. The Borough agrees to maintain in full force and effect comprehensive liability insurance, and name the Board of Education as an additional insured for this program. Additionally, the Borough shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Board of Education collectively and individually for any act of omission arising out of or in the course of the performance of the duties associated with the operation of the morning care and after care program which results in a claim by a third party.
- 6. The Board of Education shall not receive any funds and/or compensation from the program.
- 7. The Borough of Elmwood Park shall be designated as the "lead agency" under this agreement.
- 8. This agreement shall be effective commencing September 1, 2018 and shall expire on June 30, 2019. However, either party has the right to terminate this agreement for any reason on ninety (90) days written notice to the other party following the adoption of a resolution by the governing body of the entity authorizing the termination. In the even that either party defaults in the performance of any of its obligations under this agreement after receiving written notice of same and failing to cure such default within thirty (30) days of said written notice, the non-defaulting party shall be entitled to terminate this agreement.

- 9. This agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the Borough of Elmwood Park and the Elmwood Park Board of Education and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, and/or agreements either written or oral. This agreement shall not be mended, modified or altered during the terms hereof except upon mutual agreements of the parties expressed in writing and signed with the same formality as this agreement.
- 10. This agreement is conditioned upon approval of the Division of Local Government Services and the Department of Community Affairs if and to the extent such approval may be required by law or regulation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mayor Francesco A. Caramagna and Borough Clerk Keith Kazmark are hereby authorized to execute said agreement.

WHEREAS, while it is commendable that legislation is being considered to provide additional compensation to Firefighters with cancer, S-716 as currently written, without responsible amendments, will prove to be very expensive to municipalities and taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, while it is also commendable that the statute of limitations is being extended for claims involving sexual abuse, S-477 as currently written would eliminate the statute of limitations entirely leaving officials and volunteers with the near impossible task of defending a claim that is decades old; and

WHEREAS, under current law family members can already collect substantial compensation for actual losses such as medical bills, lost income as well as loss of companionship; and

WHEREAS, without appropriate amendments, the combined impact of these bills would devastate local government insurance budgets at a time when the local taxpayers are being squeezed because of changes in Federal Tax Code;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that:

- ❖ S-716 be amended to provide that the cancer presumption be limited to types of cancer that scientific evident establishes that Firefighters develop at a higher rate than the general public, and
- ❖ S-716 be amended to end the presumption at age 65 when the firefighter becomes eligible for Medicare. Alternatively, S-716 should be amended to remove volunteers and establish a special program for them along the lines recently adopted by New York, Connecticut, Michigan, Colorado and Georgia, and
- ❖ S-716 also be amended so that the standard to rebut the presumption remain at the current "preponderance of the evidence"; and
- ❖ S-477 be amended to increase statute of limitation on claims involving sexual molestation against public entities to 7 years, subject to no limitation against the molester; and
- ❖ S-1766 be amended to remove public entities from "emotional distress" compensation for wrongful death claims subject to Title 59; and
