AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER II OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "ADMINISTRATION" MORE SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE II "OFFICES CREATED" SECTION 2-7.3 TITLED "MUNICIPAL CLERK COMPENSATION, ADDITIONAL"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that there exists a need to review the wording set forth in said section of the Borough Ordinance of Elmwood Park and thereby promoting a cost savings and maximizing the service rendered and to be more efficient in its operation. And

WHEREAS, the Mayor and council wish to address the manner in which the Municipal Clerk is compensated.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter II of the code of the borough of Elmwood Park titled "Administration" more specifically section 2-7.3 titled "Municipal Clerk Compensation, Additional" shall be and is hereby amended and replaced with the following language:

"The Municipal Clerk shall receive compensation as fixed annually by the Borough Council. In addition, when the Municipal Clerk is required to be present at an election or election related matter during a time when other municipal employees are off, such as late night voter registration, primary election day and general election day, he or she will receive additional pay for such time spent at a rate of pay calculated at time and half (1.5) of the then year current hourly rate".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED All of the remaining part of the Ordinance relating to Article II known as Offices Created of the Local Government of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE UNDERTAKING OF THE ELMWOOD PARK MARINA IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$1,400,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), is hereby authorized to undertake the Elmwood Park Marina Improvement Project in, by and for the Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$1,400,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvement described in Section 1 of this ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) because this ordinance involves a project to be funded by a State grant. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$250,407 from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 9 hereof. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefitted.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of the Borough, (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of the Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$1,400,000, (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$1,400,000, and (5) the cost of said purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the

aggregate amount of \$200,000, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of said purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,400,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,400,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance, shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of the Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance, and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of fifteen years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of the Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$1,400,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of said purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of said purpose or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for said purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 11. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this ordinance.

Section 12. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

SECTION 1: Chapter 2, Article III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Department of Local Government" more specifically section 2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members.

Section a. 2. Shall be amended to read Three (3), Captains, automatically reducing to Two (2) Captains immediately upon the retirement of the Senior Captain in 2021. All of the remaining portions of said section shall remain in full force and effect.

Section a. 4. Shall be amended to read Six (6), Sergeants. All of the remaining portions of said section shall remain in full force and effect.

Section a. 5. Shall be amended to read Thirty-Three (33), Patrol Officers. All of the remaining portions of said section shall remain in full force and effect.

All of the remaining parts of the Ordinance relating to Article III, known as Department of the Local Government of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 14 ENTITLED "FIRE PREVENTION", MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 14-1.8 ENTITLED "NON-LIFE HAZARD USES" BY AMENDING AND ADDINING CERTAINS LANQUAGE CONTAINED AND A NEW USE TO THAT SECTION WITH THE PROPOSED LANGUAGE AND USE AS FOLLOWS

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions as set forth under the laws of the State of New Jersey which grants the right to a municipality to set up standards and regulations relating to the health, safety and welfare of its residents and maintain proper and safe sanitary conditions within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey has reviewed, considered the recommendations of the Fire Inspector, Building Department and the Business Administrator having determined that there is a need to amend section 14-1.8(a) to include a new use classification to be identified as R-SU and further add therein a new paragraph which will be identified as (g) which will read "Any and all residential uses that are registered and or licensed by any other agency not otherwise classified shall also be registered with fire prevention and be inspected on a regular basis. These uses shall be classified and registered as an R-SU use and pay an annual registration fee of \$75.00" for the overall safety, health and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, upon the advice and recommendation of the Fire Inspector, Borough's building department and Borough Business Administrator, the Mayor and the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park find that it is necessary to update 14-1.8 of the Code in order to bring same up to present standards so as to assist the Borough in alleviating potential health and safety condition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that Section 14-1.8 intitled "Non-Life Hazard Uses" more specifically paragraph (a) be and is hereby amended to include in the existing chart the following new classification:

Use:	Description:	Fee:
R-SU	Any and all uses registered/licensed by other agency not classified	\$75.00

And a new designated paragraph to read as follows:

g. Any and all residential uses that are registered and or licensed by any other agency not otherwise classified shall also be registered with fire prevention and be inspected on a regular basis. These uses shall be classified and registered as an R-SU use and pay an annual registration fee of \$75.

All of the existing language in said section will remain unchanged and enforceable as set forth therein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, all ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required and in accordance with the law.

- 3. In the event that a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as the holiday. In the event that a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as the holiday.
- 4. This section shall not apply to part time employees whom are compensated on an hourly basis.

SECTION VII: VACATION

1. All full-time employees shall be allowed vacation leave from their employment with continuance of compensation provided herein, in accordance with the following schedule:

All employees hired prior to January 1, 1991 that desire to enter into retirement shall receive terminal leave immediately prior to said retirement provided said employee notified the Borough prior to February 15th of the year he/she intends to retire. PERS will then be notified and the retirement application of the employee will be processed. Such leaves shall be computed at the following rate:
