The amount to finance the appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets beginning in 2022 by the inclusion of at least 1/5 of the amount authorized pursuant to this act (N.J.S. 40A:4-55).

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AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 "ADMINISTRATION" MORE SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE III OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK TITLED "DEPARTMENT OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT." MORE SPECIFICALLY, SECTION 2-27 ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT." MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 2-27.1 ENTITLED "CREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT; MEMBERS"

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the need to streamline the police department to make the same more efficient in its operation and to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 2, Article III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Department of Local Government" more specifically section 2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members, shall be amended to so as to add language to section b and add a new section intitled section c.

#### **Section b.** Shall be amended to read as follows:

In order to provide for a safe and efficient transition when a member or members of the police force give notice of their intent to retire, there shall be permitted a maximum of two additional patrol officers (in addition to the number of patrol officers set forth in Subsection a5 above) who may be employed for a maximum of six months for the purpose of training and familiarization with police procedures. The six-month provision shall apply to officers hired as part of the New Jersey Civil Service Commission Intergovernmental Transfer Program.

#### **New Section c.** shall be inserted to read as follows:

In order to provide for a safe and efficient transition, there shall also be a separate provision for officers hired off the New Jersey Civil Service eligibility list as a new police recruit. This provision shall permit a maximum of two additional patrol officers (in addition to the number of patrol officers set forth in Subsection a5 above) who may be employed for a maximum of ten months for the purpose of training and familiarization with police procedures.

**SECTION 2**: **Remaining Part Unchanged.** All of the remaining parts of the Ordinance relating to Article III, known as Department of the Local Government of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that they are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication thereof as provided by law.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 19-15 entitled:

"BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW COMMUNICATION AND SIGNAL SYSTEMS EQUIPMENT, NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$1,585,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS"

adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") on August 15, 2019 (the "Prior Ordinance") is hereby amended to (A)(i) increase the appropriation and estimated cost in Section 4.F. from \$1,192,500 to \$1,282,500 (an increase of \$90,000); (ii) increase the down payment appropriated in Section 4.F. from \$56,800 to \$61,300 (an increase of \$4,500); and (iii) increase the bonds and notes authorized in Section 4.F. from \$1,135,700 to \$1,221,200 (an increase of \$85,500); and (B)(i) increase the aggregate appropriation and estimated cost for Section 4 from \$1,585,000 to \$1,675,000 (an increase of \$90,000); (ii) increase the aggregate down payment appropriated for Section 4 from \$76,000 to \$80,500 (an increase of \$4,500); and (iii) increase the aggregate amount of bonds and notes authorized in Section 4 from \$1,509,000 to \$1,594,500 (an increase of \$85,500); and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 4. The several purposes hereby authorized for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued are set forth in the following "Schedule of Improvements, Purposes and Amounts" which schedule also shows (1) the amount of the appropriation and the estimated cost of each such purpose, and (2) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance such purposes, and (3) the estimated maximum amount of bonds and notes to be issued for each such purpose, and (4) the period of usefulness of each such purpose, according to its reasonable life, computed from the date of said bonds:

A. Acquisition of new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, consisting of SUVs for the use of the Police Department.

Undertaking of the 2019 Road Resurfacing Program at various locations (including drainage improvements and curb and sidewalk replacement, where necessary), as set forth on a list on file with the Borough Clerk and hereby approved and incorporated herein by this reference thereto. Depending upon the contract price and other exigent circumstances, and upon approval by the Borough Council, there may be additions to or deletions from the aforesaid list. It is hereby determined and stated that the roads being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. Section 5 of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to increase the estimated amount of statutorily permitted expenses included in the amount appropriated from \$210,000 to \$220,000 (an increase of \$10,000), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 5. The cost of such purposes, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$220,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purposes, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law."

Section 3. Section 6 of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to increase the down payment appropriated from \$76,000 to \$80,500 (an increase of \$4,500), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 6. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$80,500, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purposes. The sum of \$80,500 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purposes." Section 4. Section 7 of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to increase the amount of bonds authorized from \$1,509,000 to \$1,594,500 (an increase of \$85,500), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 7. To finance said purposes, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,594,500 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted."

Section 5. Section 8 of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to increase the amount of bond anticipation notes authorized from \$1,509,000 to \$1,594,500 (an increase of \$85,500), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 8. To finance said purposes, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,594,500 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding."

Section 6. Section 10 of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to increase the average period of usefulness of the purposes authorized from 9.37 years to 9.40 years (an increase of 0.03 years), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 10. It is hereby determined and declared that the average period of usefulness of said purposes, according to their reasonable lives, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or notes authorized for said purposes, is a period of 9.40 years computed from the date of said bonds."

Section 7. Section 11 of the Prior Ordinance is hereby amended to increase the amount of gross debt of the Borough shown on the Supplemental Debt Statement filed for the ordinance, as amended, from \$1,509,000 to \$1,594,500 (an increase of \$85,500), and shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 11. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$1,594,500 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law."

Section 8. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this amendatory bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

#### APPROVING COVID-19 SPECIAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been found necessary to adopt a Special Emergency Appropriation to meet certain Extraordinary COVID-19 affected revenue losses and/or additional expenditures incurred, or to be incurred, related to the COVID pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 allows a municipality to authorize special emergency appropriations for COVID-19 related revenue loss and/or additional expenditures incurred during the COVID-19 related public health emergency, and provides that it shall be lawful to adopt such special emergency, which appropriation and/or the "special emergency notes" issued to finance the same shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of an appropriation as prescribed by the act and in compliance with the Division of Local Government Services regulations set forth as part of the COVID-19 Operating Deficits and Extraordinary Expenditures: Implementation of P.L. 2020, c.74.;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, (by not less 2/3 vote of the full governing body members affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55:

- 1. The Chief Financial Officer has been directed by a resolution adopted on November 12, 2020 to make a written application and certify to the Division Director, on the prescribed form, that the deficits in revenue and additional expenditures are directly attributable to COVID-19, and said certification was approved by the governing body and submitted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
- 2. A Special Emergency Deferred Charge is hereby established for COVID-19 affective revenue losses in the total amount of \$610,000.
- 3. A Special Emergency Appropriation is hereby made for COVID-19 expenditures in the total amount of \$-0-.
- 4. That the total emergency appropriation shall be provided for in the budgets of succeeding years beginning in 2022 by the inclusion of not less than \$122,000 (must be at least one fifth of the total amount).
- 5. That all "special emergency notes", not in excess of the amount authorized pursuant to law, may be provided.
- 6. That such notes when issued shall be executed by the Borough of Elmwood Park's Chief Financial Officer and Mayor and Borough Clerk. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell said notes and any renewals thereof from time to time.
- 7. That said special emergency notes may be issued to address the cash flow and appropriation needs related to the deferred charge in compliance with the provisions of P.L. 2020, c.74.
- 8. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution will be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

# SUPPORTING AND ADVANCING THE PARTICIPATION AT PUBLIC MEETINGS THE BOROUGH ADOPTS REMOTE METING GUIDELINES WHENEVER A DECLARED EMERGENCY AND LIMITED ACCESS TO THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING IS REQUIRED

**WHEREAS**, the Division of Local Government Services due to the restrictions necessitated by COVID-19, has issued remote meeting guidance for local government entities, including the conduct of public meetings during COVID-19 pandemic, which has forced local government entities throughout New Jersey to hold public meetings remotely; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Local Government Services has promulgated emergency regulations which have been codified under N.J.A.C. 5:39-1.1 through 1.7; and

**WHEREAS**, these protocols aim to ensure continuity of government operations and transparency in conducting public business when an emergency requires a governing body meeting to be held remotely; and

**WHEREAS**, the emergency regulations enacted under Public Law 2020, c 34 section 8 presently in effect, which authorizes the Division Director to promulgate regulations establishing standard protocols for remote public meetings held by a "local public body" during a Governor-declared emergency, including minimum procedures to be followed to provide reasonable public notice and allowance for public input; and

**WHEREAS**, local public bodies are defined in the law as any public body subject to the Open Public Meetings Act N.J.S.A. 10:4-8 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park acknowledging that by directive, of the Director of Local Government Service requires that the Municipalities adopt by resolution regulation regarding protocols aim to ensure continuity of government operations and transparency in conducting public business when an emergency requires a governing body meeting to be held remotely and in compliance thereof;
