AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK MORE SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC" ARTICLE 7-8.3, "TEMPORARY NO PARKING FOR SNOW PLOWING AND REMOVAL"

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have been and are aware of multiple complaints from the residents regarding the hardship that the restriction on parking in a certain area of the Borough is causing to the residents of that area where parking is prohibited for snow plowing and removal during a snow storm; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that there is a need to remove the prohibit parking during prohibited snow conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that such limitation, control and or prohibition would adversely affect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of that area of the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that Chapter VII, Article 7-8.3 is hereby amended so as to reflect that the parking restriction for snow plowing and snow removal on "Miller Avenue" Sides "Both" Location "West of Elm Street to dead end" TO "Miller Avenue" Sides "SOUTH" Location "West of Elm Street to dead end" be and are hereby removed and that the area so identified shall no longer be subject to the parking restriction for snow plowing and or removal; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor & Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that if any provision of this amended Ordinance shall be held invalid, or contrary to the law, then such provision of the Ordinance shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of the Ordinance.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that all the other language contained therein shall still be valid and remain in full force and effect.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED, this amended Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR MA-2019-PHASE 2: MOLA BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS FISCAL YEAR
2019

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2020, the Mayor and Council approved resolution R-48-21, a resolution approving the submission of a grant application to the New Jersey Department of Transportation under the New Jersey Transportation Trust Fund Authority Act, Fiscal Year 2019 Municipal Aid Program, for the purpose of constructing Phase 2 of the Mola Boulevard Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the original grant application proposed the installation of roadway improvements along Mola Boulevard from Market Street to Linden Ave, with a construction cost estimate of \$389,145.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough was awarded a grant in the amount of \$239,000.00 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation for Phase 2 of the Mola Boulevard Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, Bergen County constructed improvements to the intersection of Market Street and Mola Boulevard and in conjunction with that project paved a portion of Mola Boulevard that overlapped the limits of the 2019 Municipal Aid Grant by nearly half; and

WHEREAS, since the project is now already partially completed, the Borough of Elmwood Park is considering adding streetscape lighting either in conjunction with or in lieu of any of the remaining milling and paving but needs additional time to evaluate the modified project costs and effects on the original grant; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is requesting a time extension of 6 months from grant deadline of March 25, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen hereby authorizes the submission to the New Jersey Department of Transportation "A request for a six-month time extension from March 25, 2021 to September 25, 2021" to determine whether they want to amend the scope and or limits of work from Market Street to Linden Place, as originally filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to sign all documents on behalf of the Borough of Elmwood Park and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement.
