WHEREAS, John Molinelli, Esq., of Price, Meese, Shulman, and D'Arminio, P.C. has the capabilities, skills, and requisite expertise to conduct a fact-finding investigation and to provide a report to the Borough which report shall contain factual findings and conclusions, and recommendations to the Borough to address and remedy the issues uncovered in his investigation.
