ORDINANCE NO.: 26-17**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BOROUGH CODE SECTION 2-32.2 (“APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT HEAD AND SUPERINTENDENT”) TO ADDRESS SUPERINTENDENT CLASSIFICATION OPTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, as follows:

SECTION 1.

Borough Code Sections 2-32.2 (“Appointment of Public Works Department Head and Superintendent”), be and hereby is amended as follows:

§ 2-32.2. Appointment of Public Works Department Head and Superintendent.

There shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council, a Public Works Department Head, which shall be an unclassified position pursuant to Civil Service law. There shall also be appointed by the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the Public Works Department Head, and confirmed by the Council, a Superintendent of Public Works. The appointment of the Superintendent of Public Works shall be made in accordance with Civil Service law.

SECTION 2. Repealer

All Ordinances and parts thereof conflicting herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability

If any section, paragraph subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.

SECTION 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
