#### BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK ORDINANCE #15-20

BOND ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF \$128,000 FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF BOULEVARD (SECTIONS 8, 9 AND 10) IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has heretofore authorized the improvement of Boulevard (Sections 8 and 9), consisting of road resurfacing and the undertaking of drainage, curb and sidewalk improvements, where necessary, in, by and for said Borough and appropriated the sum of \$225,000 therefor pursuant to ordinance no. 14-25 adopted by the Borough Council of said Borough on December 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council now finds and determines that the additional sum of \$128,000 is required for such purpose and the extension of such purpose to include the improvement of Boulevard (Section 10), NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough"), as follows:

Section 1. The additional sum of \$128,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of (i) the purpose (improvement of Boulevard (Sections 8 and 9)) authorized by ordinance no. 14-25 adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough on December 4, 2014 (the "Prior Ordinance") and (ii) the improvement of Boulevard (Section 10) hereby authorized (collectively, the "purpose" or the "improvement"). Said additional appropriation shall be met from the down payment appropriated and from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. Said improvement has been and shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost

thereof has been nor shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvement is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$353,000, including the sum of \$225,000 appropriated by the Prior Ordinance and the \$128,000 appropriated by this ordinance, and (4) \$17,100 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment, including the \$11,000 appropriated by the Prior Ordinance and the \$6,100 hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$335,900, including the \$214,000 authorized by the Prior Ordinance and the \$121,900 hereinafter authorized, and (6) the additional cost of such purpose includes the aggregate amount of \$73,000, including the sum of \$35,000 stated in the Prior Ordinance and the sum of \$38,000 hereby stated, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$6,100, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$6,100 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$121,900 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$121,900 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt

in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$121,900 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement authorized by the Prior Ordinance and this ordinance, as described herein. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to

reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 11. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 12. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 13. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

SECTION 1: Article 22-1.6, Chapter 22 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park entitled "Curb, Sidewalk and Driveway Openings: Requirements" is hereby amended by deleting any reference to "two (2) years" and replacing "two (2) years" with "five "5" years".

#### **SECTION 2:** Repealer

All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. AUTHORIZE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT JEFFREY R. SURENIUM & ASSOCIATES, LLC. COAH DECLARITORY JUDGEMENT FILING

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park has filed or anticipates filing a Declaratory Judgment Action in the Superior Court of New Jersey Bergen County in furtherance of the Supreme Court's March 10, 2015 decision captioned <u>In re Adoption of N.J.A.C. 5:96 & 5:97 by N.J. Council on Affordable Housing</u>, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) (the "Supreme Court Decision"); and

WHEREAS, Fair Share Housing Center ("FSHC"), through the services of David Kinsey, has prepared what it considers to be the statewide fair share numbers (the "FSHC Numbers") for use by the 15 vicinage Mt. Laurel Judges to calculate a municipality's affordable housing obligation pursuant to the Supreme Court Decision; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park desires to participate in the preparation of a statewide fair share analysis to be undertaken by Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey ("Rutgers"), through Dr. Robert W. Burchell, Principal Investigator, and various other experts employed by Rutgers in order to establish a rational and reasonable methodology (the "Burchell Fair Share Analysis") for determination of a municipality's obligation to provide a realistic opportunity through its land use ordinances for its fair share of the region's affordable housing needs in accordance with the Mount Laurel Doctrine as set forth in In the Matter of the Adoption of N.J.A.C. 5:96 and 5:97 by the New Jersey Council on Affordable Housing, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) ("Decision") and prior decisions of the Courts of New Jersey, and the Fair Housing Act, N.J.S.A. 52:27D-301 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, Rutgers, utilizing Dr. Burchell as the Principal Investigator and author has agreed to prepare the Burchell Fair Share Analysis within 90 days of being retained to establish his view of the proper way to determine each municipality's fair share obligation; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Burchell estimates the cost to prepare the initial Burchell Fair Share Analysis will be \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that there will be a need for Dr. Burchell to analyze any challenges to his conclusions and prepare a rebuttal report to said challenges which is not included in the \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that if each municipality contributes \$2,000, there will be sufficient monies to pay the cost to prepare the initial Burchell Fair Share Analysis, to analyze any challenges to the Initial Fair Share Analysis and to Prepare A Rebuttal Report given the number of municipalities that have expressed an interest in retaining Burchell; and

WHEREAS, a Municipal Shared Services Defense Agreement (hereinafter MSSDA"), has been prepared (a) so that monies can be collected to enter into an agreement with Rutgers (hereinafter "the Rutgers Agreement") and so that Burchell, along with various other experts from Rutgers, can perform the tasks described above and (b) so that the rights and responsibilities of each municipality that wishes to sign the agreement to retain Rutgers are defined; and

WHEREAS, the MSSDA provides that the Law Offices of Jeffrey R. Surenian and Associates, LLC ("Surenian") will serve as the administrative entity to sign the Rutgers agreement on behalf of the municipalities that signed the MSSDA and paid the \$2,000 fee; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative given the time constraints for municipalities that wish to retain Burchell to sign the MSSDA and pay the \$2,000 fee so that Burchell can conduct the necessary analysis; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the foregoing, it is possible that the MSSDA may need to be changed as a result of ongoing negotiations with the Rutgers agreement following execution of the MSSDA and the payment of the \$2,000 fee; and

WHEREAS, in such an event, any member that objects to the changes that Rutgers may require shall have the opportunity to relinquish membership in the Municipal Group and to receive back the \$2,000 payment as more specifically set forth in the MSSDA.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, as follows:

- 1. The terms and conditions of the MSSDA attached hereto are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.
- 2. The amount of \$2,000 is hereby authorized to be expended by the Borough of Elmwood Park for Rutgers through Dr. Robert Burchell, Principal Investigator to prepare the Burchell Fair Share Analysis.
- 3. A certification of funds authorizing the aforesaid expenditure has been signed by the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Elmwood Park and is appended hereto.
- 4. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid MSSDA to memorialize the participation of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the preparation of the Burchell Fair Share Analysis and to take any and all actions reasonably required to effectuate said Agreement.
- 5. The Borough of Elmwood Park hereby authorizes Jeffrey R. Surenian, Esq. to execute on behalf of the Borough of Elmwood Park the Research Agreement with Rutgers to initiate and complete Burchell Fair Share Analysis and to do such other actions to effectuate the purposes of said Research Agreement.
- 6. If further changes to the MSSDA are needed as a result of finalizing the Rutgers Agreement, within ten (10) days of notification by Surenian of the changes, the Borough of Elmwood Park will inform Surenian if it objects to the changes and wishes to withdraw from the Municipal Group and obtain a refund of the \$2000 it paid.
- 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

# AUTHORIZE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM ELMWOOD PARK BOARD OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., authorized local units of the State of New Jersey to enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units to provide or receive any service that each local unit in the participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive in its own jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park (hereafter also referred to as "Borough") is in need of morning care and after care services for school children; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park Board of Education (hereafter also referred to as "Board of Education") currently provides morning care and after care services for school children; and

WHEREAS, the Elmwood Park Board of Education has decided that it will cease providing morning care and after care services for school children; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park has discussed with the Elmwood Park Board of Education taking over the morning care and after care services for school children; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated an agreement for the aforementioned; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of this undertaking are set below; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park and the Elmwood Park Board of Education in an effort to more economically and efficiently provide governmental services, the governing bodies have each duly authorized their proper officials to enter into and execute this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in consideration of the mutual convenants and promises hereafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. The Borough shall be responsible for the hiring, paying, bookkeeping, collecting, etc. associated with the day-to-day operation of the morning care and after care services.
- 2. The Board of Education shall permit the Borough to use the Board of Education facilities located at the various schools, during the hours of 7:30a.m. to 8:30a.m. Monday through Friday during the school year. The program will not operate during emergency closings due to weather, when there is a delayed opening or on any days that schools are closed.
- 3. All staff that are provided by the Borough for this program agree to provide the necessary supervision and administration inherent in providing this program. Prior to the commencement of employment, all staff will submit to a criminal background check/fingerprinting either at their own expense or at the expense of the Borough, the results of which shall be provided upon request of the Board.
- 4. The Borough shall operate the program in compliance with all State laws and codes. Staff to include child ratios shall meet New Jersey licensing requirements.
- 5. The Borough agrees to maintain in full force and effect comprehensive liability insurance, and name the Board of Education as an additional insured for this program. Additionally, the Borough shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Board of Education collectively and individually for any act of omission arising out of or in the course of the performance of the duties associated with the operation of the morning care and after care program which results in a claim by a third party.

- 6. The Board of Education shall not receive any funds and/or compensation from the program.
- 7. The Borough of Elmwood Park shall be designated as the "lead agency" under this agreement.
- 8. This agreement shall be effective commencing August 1, 2015 and shall expire on July 31, 2016. However, either party has the right to terminate this agreement for any reason on ninety (90) days written notice to the other party following the adoption of a resolution by the governing body of the entity authorizing the termination. In the even that either party defaults in the performance of any of its obligations under this agreement after receiving written notice of same and failing to cure such default within thirty (30) days of said written notice, the non-defaulting party shall be entitled to terminate this agreement.
- 9. This agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the Borough of Elmwood Park and the Elmwood Park Board of Education and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, and/or agreements either written or oral. This agreement shall not be mended, modified or altered during the terms hereof except upon mutual agreements of the parties expressed in writing and signed with the same formality as this agreement.
- 10. This agreement is conditioned upon approval of the Division of Local Government Services and the Department of Community Affairs if and to the extent such approval may be required by law or regulation.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that Mayor Richard A. Mola and Borough Clerk Keith Kazmark are hereby authorized to execute said agreement.

A motion was made by Councilman Caramanga and seconded by Councilman Pettigano to add R-309-15 to the meeting agenda. Councilman Colletti discussed a request for a Place-to-Place liquor license transfer and two objections that were made against the transfer. Councilman Colletti discussed his thoughts pertaining to the request to transfer and affect it may have on the current license holders that are objecting. Councilman Vuoncino discussed the Council's ability to waive the distance restriction when the applicant shows a hardship. He stated the applicant did prove to him that a hardship exists and failure to grant the waiver could essentially cause the business to go out of business. He further stated the Council needs to investigate why the ordinance was not followed in the past. Councilman Colletti stated the third business coming into the area will cause a hardship for the already established businesses in the area. Councilman Dombrowski inquired as to why nail salons or delis are not regulated with distance requirements. Discussion then ensued to the distance requirements that are State statutes. Councilman Dombrowski discussed the number of liquor licenses that exist in the Borough and the size of the Borough and how the number of licenses can be accommodated. Discussion ensued as to whether or not waivers have been granted in the past. Borough Clerk Kazmark discussed the retention schedule pertaining to liquor license files and the inability to know for sure if a waiver was granted in the past. Councilman Vuoncino stated that if a waiver has been granted in the past that would have set a precedence. A roll call was taken to add the resolution to the agenda. Motion carried with Councilman Colletti being the only nay vote.

## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Councilman Martino reported progress.

Councilman Pettigano announced various upcoming Recreation programs. He further discussed the Recreation Department taking over the responsibility of the Before/After School program beginning in September.

Councilman Colletti stated the next JIF meeting is in September. He discussed the Elmwood Park Fire Department holding a mutual aid drill recently which included seven other departments.

Councilman Caramagna reported that he recently visited the high school and observed the improvements being made.

Councilman Vuoncino discussed the Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over resolution which was adopted tonight. He discussed the graduation of the Junior Police Academy. He reported that the Mayor and Council will hold a joint meeting with the Library Board on September 21, 2015 to discuss the capital improvements at the Library. The Councilman announced the Annual Volunteer Ambulance Corps. Car Show.

Council President Dombrowski thanked the committee who helped put together National Night Out. He thanked the groups who participated. He congratulated the Little League division championship team. The Council President discussed signs which other towns post acknowledging championship teams and feels Elmwood Park should do the same. He asked for the Council's support. The Council President discussed upcoming road construction at the train tracks on the Boulevard and the instillation of the force main line on Market Street.

## PUBLIC COMMENTS

Karen Varrecchia, Lee Street, discussed the phone call she received from the Borough Clerk advising of the Market Street force main project as a business owner. She suggested the project start date be held until after the opening of school and the St. Leo's Fair. She also addressed Councilman Colletti regarding his earlier comments about the Liquor License transfer. She questioned why there are so many other businesses which are permitted to be open close to one another. Discussion between Mrs. Varrecchia and Councilman Colletti ensued. The Council President discussed permitting and the need to complete the job before the winter. Mr. Kazmark stated that there are multiple project planned for Market Street and they need to be completed in a certain sequence.

Kenneth Arabia, Locust Street discussed road rage in town. He requested a turning lane on Locust Street. Mr. Arabia discussed pieces of a car around the Municipal Building. He would also like to see the garbage under the bridges cleaned up, especially at Center Street. Mr. Arabia discussed it being dark behind the Municipal Building. The Council President advised that the Borough needs to pole number to get out lights corrected. He discussed a female police officer driving a vehicle with a head light out.

Jeff Marston, Elizabeth Avenue, discussed a film production event at Rosemont Park. He listed several complaints regarding the production shoot. Mr. Kazmark responded by stating that the some of Mr. Marston's comments were not accurate. He also inquired as to ADA compliance with regards to the before/after school program. Council President Dombrowski stated the Council is not knowledgeable regarding the ADA requirements and with the absence of the Borough Attorney the Council will not respond to any questions regarding ADA compliance at this time.

James D'Amico, Willow Street reminded the Council of the upcoming Homeowner's Meeting.

A motion was made by Councilman Martino and seconded by Councilman Colletti to close the public portion. Motion carried unanimously.
