
WHEREAS, Councilman Stephen Martino tenured his resignation effective September 1, 2016; and





BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION OF A SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS SYSTEM FOR THE USE OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$375,498 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO APPROPRIATE A FEDERAL GRANT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery consisting of a self-contained breathing apparatus system for the use of the Fire Department in, by and for said Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$375,498 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvement described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized, and the down payment and the \$355,498 Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency (the "FEMA Grant") appropriated, by this ordinance. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvement is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$375,498, and (4) \$355,498 of said sum is to be provided by the FEMA Grant hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) \$1,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (6) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$19,000, and (7) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$5,498 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that the sum of \$355,498 received or to be received as the FEMA Grant is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of such purpose.

Section 5. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$1,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$1,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$19,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 7. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$19,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local

Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 8. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of fifteen years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 10. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$19,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 11. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose (other than the FEMA Grant hereinbefore appropriated which shall be applied to the cost of such purpose, but shall not be applied to the payment of outstanding bond anticipation notes and the reduction of the amount of bonds authorized), shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 12. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 13. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 14. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 15. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.



ORDINANCE 16-20**

**AN ORDINANCE TO BAN SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES OWNED OR LEASED BY
THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, N.J.**

WHEREAS, the Surgeon General of the United States has determined:

- A. Smoking has been casually linked to lung cancer, arteriosclerosis, and coronary heart disease, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and other conditions that constitute a wide array of serious health consequences.
- B. Smoking and smokeless tobacco use are “almost always initiated and established in adolescence”, typically by age 16.
- C. Active smoking by young people is associated with significant health problems during childhood and adolescence with increased risk factors for health problems in adulthood. (Preventing Tobacco Use Among Young People: A report of the Surgeon General, issued in 1994); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park finds that it is the best interest to discourage children from the temptations of experimenting with cigarettes and other tobacco products; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Elmwood Park finds that it is within the public interest and more specifically the health and welfare interest of children and adolescents to prohibit the use of tobacco products within public places where children congregate, gather, play and/or engage in athletic competitions; and

WHEREAS, smoking or carrying lighted tobacco may be prohibited by the owner or person responsible for operating any public place or by Municipal ordinance under the authority of N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 2C:33-13b; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Elmwood Park has determined that Borough-operated parks, playgrounds, athletic facilities, ball fields, buildings and properties owned or leased by the Borough of Elmwood Park are public places where children congregate, play, gather and/or engage in athletic competitions and, therefore, should be free from the existence of tobacco use and second-hand smoke;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Police Regulations" is hereby amended by adding a new section to be designated as Ordinance 3-7 as follows:

**§3-7 SMOKING PROHIBITED IN PUBLIC PLACES OWNED OR LEASED BY
THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, BERGEN COUNTY, N.J.**

3-7.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to use, possess or maintain any lighted tobacco products or other smoke producing products within any public right of way of any property owned or leased by the Borough of Elmwood Park, including parks, playgrounds, ball fields, athletic facilities, and all buildings and properties owned or leased by the Borough of Elmwood Park ;

3-7.2 ENFORCEMENT PROVISION

This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Elmwood Park Police Department or its designees. Any person who commits a violation of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a fine not to exceed \$200 providing that, in accordance with 2C:33-13b, adequate notice of such prohibition has been conspicuously posted. Any person may inform any person perceived to be violating this Ordinance, of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 2. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.





BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Chapter II of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park, entitled "Administration" is hereby amended, and specifically Ordinance 2-27.1, titled "Creation of the Department; Members" by deleting the existing section and replacing it with the following:

2-27.1 Creation of the Department; Members.

There are hereby created the following positions in the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park:

1. One (1) Chief of Police;
2. Two (2) Captains;
3. Five (5) Lieutenants until July 31, 2018; subsequent to that date, there shall be Four (4) Lieutenants;
4. Four (4) Sergeants.
5. A maximum of Twenty nine (29) Patrolmen

b. In order to provide for a safe and efficient transition when a member or members of the police force give notice of their intent to retire, there shall be permitted a maximum of two additional Patrolmen (in addition to the number of Patrolmen set forth in a. 5 above) who may be employed for a maximum of six months for the purpose of training and familiarization with police procedures.



COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed the 9/11 Memorial which was held on the new football field. She thanked all involved who put the memorial together. She discussed the upcoming Board of Education meeting. She further discussed Alumni Day that will be held at the high school on September 17, 2016.

Councilman Dombrowski discussed the upcoming flu and rabies clinics which are being held by the Health Department. He further discussed the Homeowners Association meeting which will be held on September 28, 2016 will have County Clerk John Hogan as a guest speaker. He discussed an upcoming casino trip which is being sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce. Councilman Dombrowski urged residents to attend the upcoming Library Board meeting and also urged the Council to revisit the ordinance regarding Borough owned buildings which was vetoed by Mayor Mola on December 31, 2016.

Council President Vuoncino discussed his memories pertaining to the events that unfolded on September 11, 2001. He further discussed the changes over the years that followed. The Council President discussed the role that EMS workers played on September 11th and presently.

Councilman Colletti stated there was nothing to report with the JIF or the Recreation Department due to no recent meetings being held. He discussed the recent house fire and the importance of a functioning smoke detectors.

Councilman Chirido discussed ongoing projects with the Department of Public Works. He further stated that certified letters were sent out regarding dead or dieing trees located in the right-of-way so that they can be addressed by the homeowners. He discussed the efforts being made to improve the street cleaning within the Borough. Councilman Chirido discussed the accident in which a man was struck by a train over River Road. Councilman Caramagna discussed his memories from September 11, 2001.

Mayor Mola discussed the differences between the attack on Pearl Harbor and the attacks on September 11, 2001.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ken Arabia, Locust Street, discussed traffic issues from East 54 Street onto Main Avenue. He discussed loud traffic noise existing during the afternoon work commute. Borough Clerk Kazmark will forward the complaint to the Police Chief.

Rich Trawisnki, Walnut Street, discussed an upcoming Library Board meeting. He urged the Council and the residents to attend the Library Board meeting to hear the discussion regarding the capital plan.

He encouraged the Council to get behind a parking schedule to get vehicles off the street for the street cleaning. He discussed the Council passing an ordinance which helped some of the residents on Gilbert Avenue near the elementary school with leaf pickup.

Dan Golabek, Godwin Avenue, inquired as to who the liaison is to the Library Board. Mayor Mola stated he sits on the Library Board. Mr. Golabek inquired as to whether there was anything to report from the prior meeting. Mayor Mola stated he was not at the previous meeting and he did not have any information available at this time. Mr. Golabek discussed the response received

by the Library Board President when asked about a document. He encouraged the Council to pass the ordinance which would require the Council's approval on construction performed on Borough owned buildings. Mr. Golabek discussed the history of the process taken regarding recycling bins throughout the community. He inquired as to what is being done regarding the project. Discussion ensued as to the Council awaiting a response from the contractor that submitted a bid. Mr. Golabek stated the Council should reach out to the company so that the project can move forward. Council President Vuoncino stated that is not the responsibility of the Council to continually reach out to the contractor, it is the responsibility of the contractor to be responsive. Mr. Golabek expressed his thoughts regarding the proposed stipend program for the Fire Department. He then inquired about the Market Street Streetscape and the grant funding that was received. Mr. Golabek discussed his thoughts as to whether the Borough should expend funds to get additional funding. Council President Vuoncino stated that he commented at the meeting Mr. Golabek referenced that applying for funding if it aligns with something the Council is already pursuing.


