CALENDAR YEAR 2018 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year=s final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2018 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous years final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$192,751 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2018 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$674,628 and that the CY 2018 municipal budget for the Borough of Elmwood Park be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-78b has authorized the Local Finance Board to adopt rules that permit municipalities in sound fiscal condition to assume the responsibility, normally granted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, of conducting the annual budget examination, and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7 was adopted by the Local Finance Board on February 11, 1997, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.2 thru 7.5 the Borough of Elmwood Park has been declared eligible to participate in the program by the Division of Local Government Services, and the Chief Financial Officer has determined that the Borough meets the necessary conditions to participate in the program for the 2018 budget year, so now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification. The governing body has found the budget has met the following requirements:

- 1. That with reference to the following items, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget:
 - a. Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
 - b. Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
 - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes
- 2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at 40A:4-45.3 et seq. are fully met (Complies with the "CAP" law.)
- 3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
- 4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate, and correctly stated,
 - b. Items of appropriation are properly set forth
 - c. In itemization, form, arrangement, and content the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.
- 5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced, publicly advertised, and in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.
- 6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE RESURFACING OF PORTIONS OF FRANKLIN STREET, ORCHARD STREET AND LEE STREET IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$240,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the resurfacing of portions of Franklin Street, Orchard Street and Lee Street (including construction of ADA handicapped access curb ramps and drainage improvements, where necessary) in, by and for said Borough. It is hereby determined and stated that said roads being improved are of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. The sum of \$240,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that a \$124,351 grant from the Bergen County Community Development Program, pursuant to the Federal Housing and Community Development Act, shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 10 hereof. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law, and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$240,000, and (4) \$12,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$228,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$40,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$12,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$12,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$228,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$228,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$228,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND Sections of ORDINANCE 2-2 of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "POLICE DEPARTMENT" by amending Sections 2-27.11, 2-27.21 and 2-27.22.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. Sections 2-27.11, 2-27.21 and 2-27.22 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

2-27.11 Disciplinary Hearings.

- (a) In any investigation of a police officer that results in disciplinary charges, which charges seek to suspend, demote or terminate a permanent police officer on charges that the officer has violated one or more of the provisions of N.J.A.C. 4A:2-2.3, or violation of the internal rules and regulations of the Police Department, or any state statute, or the implicit standard of good conduct, and the police officer requests a hearing, the Appropriate Authority, or its designee, shall sit as Hearing Officer for the Borough.
- (b) In the event the Appropriate Authority does not act as Hearing Officer, the Appropriate Authority may appoint, via resolution, any individual its deems qualified, appropriate and in the best interests of the Borough to serve as Hearing Officer. The Hearing Officer designated to hear the disciplinary matter shall, at the conclusion of the hearing, forward his/her findings and recommendations to the Appropriate Authority, who shall make the final determination. The Appropriate Authority's decision shall be reviewable in accordance with civil service law and regulations, as may be amended from time to time, as provided in N.J.S.A. 11A:1-1, et seq. and N.J.A.C. 4A:2-1, et. seq.

2-27.21 Appeals from Penalties.

See 2-27.11 (b).

2-27.22 Misconduct Observed by Police Personnel.

Whenever any member observes, or is informed of, the misconduct of another member or employee, he or she shall render a complete written report of the incident to the Chief of Police, through the chain of command.

<u>Section 2</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Chirdo discussed the Homeowners Association meeting and the meeting dates being placed on the Borough's website.

Councilman Dombrowski discussed the emergency standby call in for the Fire Department and Ambulance Corps. during the snow storm. He discussed the need to clear away snow from the fire hydrants and if elderly or disabled residents are in need of help to clear snow from a fire hydrant they can call the Fire Department to be put on a list. He also discussed the student walkout in response to the recent school shootings that were being done across the country.

Councilwoman Pellegrine discussed the upcoming Rabies clinic, the Board of Health meeting and an upcoming presentation by Bergen County Animal Control regarding the local wildlife. She discussed an upcoming Meet and Greet with the Police Department and the recent Chamber of Commerce meeting.

Councilwoman Giandomenico discussed the recent EPVAC meeting and asked for residents to make donations to the Ambulance Corps.

Councilwoman Balistrieri discussed the Recreation Department's events and programs, the Department of Public Works projects and the recent snow storm and the improvements to the water tank.

Council President Golabek discussed the budget summery, the Freeholder's budget and increase to School Aid and a meeting he had regarding the "Access For All" program.

Mayor Caramagna discussed the installation of the Borough clock and the correspondence with Governor Murphy regarding the request for sound barriers on Route 80. He further discussed a recycling meeting, the student walk out and Police Department awards. He also discussed visiting local businesses.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Victor Jimenez, Elmhurst Street, discussed a resident who leaves his truck parked in front of other people's homes for days. He stated he sought help from the Police Department but the resident seems to know how to avoid a summons by moving the vehicle after the tires have been marked. He asked the Mayor and Council to help the residents of Elmhurst who many have had issues with the particular resident.

James Damico, Willow Street, confirmed the problems with the resident that Mr. Jimenez spoke about. He stated that many residents chose to move because of this particular neighbor.

Dominic Scalcione, East 54th Street, inquired how the increased school aid would affect the budget. Council President Golabek stated that is a question that should be posed to the Board of Education.

Jean Freitag, Hillman Drive, discussed the Facebook post that was made by Mayor Caramagna regarding the walkout by the students. She also discussed the perimeter set up by the Police Department which prevented her from accessing the school even though she was a Board of Education Trustee.

Michael Bufis, Philip Avenue, discussed resident's safety and the trees located on Borough property at the end of Lee Street. He also discussed cars parked too close to crosswalks and snow plowing.

Doris Wechtler, Philip Avenue, inquired if the Mayor and Council would consider 4 way stop signs on Spiedel Avenue same as along Elm Street.

Thomas Conboy, Tuella Avenue, stated the Department of Public Works employees did a great job during the snow storm and inquired as to the 2018 Road Program. He stated that Tuella Avenue should be considered to be included.

Richard Trawinski, discussed the hiring of the DPW temporary clerical employee. He also discussed the ability to transfer calls from the DPW to another office when needed. He discussed a phone app that allows residents to report the location of potholes.

A motion was made by Councilman Dombrowski and seconded by Council President Golabek to close the public portion. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Councilman Chirdo and seconded by Councilman Dombrowski to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
