PERSON-PERSON, PLACE-PLACE LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER

0211-44-001-008

WHEREAS, an application has been filed for a person-to-person, place-place transfer of Plenary Retail Distribution License, 0211-44-001-008, heretofore issued to BNJ Group, LLC. as a “pocketed” license; and

WHEREAS, the submitted application form with the premises to be located at 465 Mola Boulevard is complete in all respects, the transfer fees have been paid, and the license has been properly renewed for the current license term; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all standards established by Title 33 of the New Jersey Statutes, regulations promulgated thereunder, as well conditions consistent with Title 33; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has disclosed, and the issuing authority reviewed the source of all funds used in the purchase of the license and the licensed business and all additional financing obtained in connection with the licensed business; and

WHEREAS, there was an investigation by the local police department and said investigation revealed that said new premises for licensing are located with 500’ (five hundred feet) from a private school and a public playground and recreation area as described in the Borough’s local ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the above referred to investigation revealed that the premises is within the 500’ (five hundred feet) distance from a private child care facility (KinderCastle) which is 454’ (four hundred fifty four feet) which the Council considers as a private school; as well as a Snack Shack located at the Little League playground which is operated in limited basis in providing snacks when there is a sporting event as well as the Little League Field is used occasionally for games and sporting events; and

WHEREAS, the Council has been assured that the use of the license by the licensee/transferee shall be for the sole purpose of selling containers of liquor and/or alcoholic beverages to be made part of liquor baskets to be shipped out and/or sold as part of a gift basket arrangement; and

WHEREAS, the Council has the right to place restrictive use on said transfer of license and, having considered the findings of the above investigation, and concludes that a waiver of the 500’ (five hundred feet) distance requirement would be reasonable and fair under the circumstance of this particular case; and

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that this waiver would not be detrimental to the health, safety, morals and the general welfare of the community, since the use of said license shall be restricted to the sale of liquor for gift basket use and shall not be sold individually as a container alone;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that as a condition of the above waiver for the 500’ (five hundred feet) requirement, the Plenary Retail Distribution License to The Gift Group, Inc. shall be restricted to the sale of said liquor and/or alcoholic beverage to be sold solely as part of and contained only in a gift basket and not sold in any individual containers by the licensee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governing Body of Elmwood Park does hereby approve, effective December 19, 2019, the transfer of the aforesaid Plenary Retail Distribution License to The Gift Group, Inc. and does hereby direct the Municipal Clerk to endorse the license certificate to the new ownership as follows: “This license, subject to all its terms and conditions, is hereby transferred to The Gift Group, Inc. effective December 19, 2019.”

He stated that he feels the ordinance will have a major impact on existing cape cods if homeowners choose or have to rebuild as they will have to go in front of the planning board. Additionally, it will affect assessments and result in an increase of tax appeals. Mr. Trawinski posed questions as to when the most recent Master Plan was completed and if the ordinance was sent to the Planning Board for review as he feels statutory requirements were not met. AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER XXXIV, ARTICLE VIII BULK REQUIREMENTS, SECTION 34-17 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH, ENTITLED TABLE OF LOT AND BUILDING REGULATIONS, TO INCREASE THE RESIDENTIAL MINIMUM LOT SIZES FOR TWO FAMILY AND SEMI-DETACHED DWELLINGS FROM 5,000 SQUARE FEET TO 7,500 SQUARE FEET AND THE MINIMUM LOT WIDTH AND FRONTAGE FROM 50 FEET TO 75 FEET.

PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the regulation of minimum lot sizes, lot widths, and lot frontage is fundamental to the Borough’s zoning policy; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to provide a means to address the overcrowding of the off-street parking conditions for the residents and citizens of our community, to control the flow of traffic congestion and; to help protect the public and to regulate to a limited degree the density of construction taking into consideration the density of population, size of streets and public rights-of-way; and to promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey has reviewed, considered and has determined that there is a need for the overall safety, health and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to amend the bulk requirements setforth at §34-17 of the Borough’s Zoning and Site Plan Review Code so as to prevent overburdening the off-street parking situation and controlling overcrowding and the density of structures and buildings which has a detrimental effect on the Borough as a whole; and

WHEREAS, upon the advice and recommendation of the Borough’s Planner and Engineer, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park find that increasing the residential minimum lot sizes, lot widths, and lot frontages for two-family and semi-detached dwellings setforth at §34-17 of the Borough’s code is reasonable and necessary to assist the Borough in alleviating the current off-street parking situation, controlling overcrowding and the density of structures and buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that the minimum lot sizes, minimum lot areas, and minimum lot widths set forth at Chapter XXXIV “Zoning and Site Plan Review,” Article VIII “Bulk Requirements,” Section 34-17 “Table of Lot and Building Regulations” regulating two-family and semi-detached dwellings in the Borough’s R-5, R-18, and R-MF Districts be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the provisions of this Ordinance are determined to be consistent with the Master Plan, where in the 2004 Master Plan Re-examination, “A principal goal of this plan is to preserve and protect the residential character and existing density of the community”, and where in the 2010 Master Plan, a primary concern was identified regarding two-family and semi-attached residential units on “small lot sizes, limited driveway space and the lack of parking areas creates conflicts”, and this Ordinance will work to resolve these goals and conflicts.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the provisions of this Ordinance will better effectuate the off-street parking requirements contained within Section 34-44, where off-street parking is required at a rate of 2 spaces per each unit, one of which must be within a garage, but the current minimum lot width and lot area poses constraints on the available lot area to comply with this requirement and this Ordinance will work to resolve these goals and conflicts.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all remaining parts of the existing ordinance not otherwise listed in the table above remain in full force and effect, but any parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed and replaced.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that except under circumstances in which the savings provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-49 and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-52 of the Municipal Land Use Law apply, at the time of final passage and adoption these amendments shall apply to all vacant unimproved two-family lots and lots containing attached and semi-detached dwellings, so situated in the Borough's R-5, R-18, and R-MF Districts.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-68 of the Municipal Land Use Law, any two-family and/or semi-detached dwelling on a conforming lot, which was constructed and in existence at the time of final passage and adoption of this amendment to the Borough's zoning ordinances, and which would be nonconforming solely by reason of the increase in the minimum lot sizes, minimum lot areas, and/or minimum lot widths set forth herein, shall not be deemed nonconforming by virtue of this amendment unless and until such structure is demolished or more than partially destroyed in conformance with Sections 34-2.3 and 34-48. All property owners will be notified to obtain a certificate of legally existing non-conforming status within 1 year of adoption where applicable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.

1. All Borough employees for who there is provided herein an annual compensation shall be excused from the performance of their duties with continuance of pay on the following days:

(8) Personal Days - Designated Department Heads Only (Effective January 1, 2015)	

2. *Floater Holiday
3. In the event that a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as the holiday. In the event that a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as the holiday.
4. This section shall not apply to part time employees whom are compensated on an hourly basis.

SECTION VII: VACATION

1. All full-time employees shall be allowed vacation leave from their employment with continuance of compensation provided herein, in accordance with the following schedule:

First year through five years of service	12 days
Completion of the fifth year to ten years of service	12 days plus one day for each year up to 17 days
Completion of ten years of service	21 days
Completion of twelve years of service	22 days
Completion of fourteen years of service	23 days
Completion of sixteen years of service	24 days
Completion of eighteen years of service	25 days
Completion of twenty years of service and thereafter	30 days

2. All employees hired after January 1, 2007 cannot accumulate vacation days other than accrued days from (1) year prior.

SECTION VIII: TERMINAL LEAVE

1. All employees hired prior to January 1, 1991 that desire to enter into retirement shall receive terminal leave immediately prior to said retirement provided said employee notified the Borough prior to February 15th of the year he/she intends to retire. PERS will then be notified and the retirement application of the employee will be processed. Such leaves shall be computed at the following rate:

1 to 7 years	1 month
8 to 14 years	2 months
15 to 21 years	3 months
22 years and over	4 months

2. In addition to leave granted above, each employee shall receive enumeration for ½ of all accumulated sick days from January 1, 1962 immediately prior to retirement of such employee with a maximum accumulation of 120 working days.

3. All employees hired on or after January 1, 1991, shall receive the following terminal leave:

After 10 years of service	1 month
After 20 years of service	2 months

4. Each employee shall receive his terminal leave payment as a lump sum payment as of the last day of the performance of duty before commencement of his terminal leave.

SECTION IX: SICK/VACATION DAYS FOR FULL TIME CROSSING GUARDS

1. All full-time crossing guards shall receive 10 sick/vacation days per school year, September through June. At the end of the school year, all full-time crossing guards will receive an additional pay of \$25.00 per day for each sick/vacation day not used during the school year.

SECTION X: REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES

1. All prior Department Head, Non-Union and Part Time Salary Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION XI: EFFECTIVE DATE




STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This Resolution is being presented, considered and adopted so that the Borough of Elmwood Park can be designate in its entirety as an “Area in Need of Rehabilitation” in accordance with the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14.

WHEREAS, the Borough’s planning consulting firm, Topology NJ, LLC (“Topology”), has investigated and researched the status of the existing conditions in the entirety of the Borough of Elmwood Park including the age of the existing housing stock; and

WHEREAS, Topology’s findings, presented in a memorandum dated October 29th, 2019 (the “October 29th Topology Memorandum”) include the fact that 82% of the residential housing structures were built before 1969 and, therefore, are at least 50 years old; and

WHEREAS, by prior resolution R-452-19 adopted by the Borough Council directed the Borough Planning Board to investigate and determine whether the Borough of Elmwood Park in its entirety (the “delineated area”) meets the criteria of the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14) as an “Area in Need of Rehabilitation”; and

WHEREAS, on a work session on December 4, 2019 and in a public meeting held on December 11, 2019, the Borough Planning Board reviewed, discussed and considered the request of the Borough Council to consider whether the Borough of Elmwood park should qualify as an Area in Need of Rehabilitation, and having considered same from the information received regarding the age and physical condition of the Borough’s housing stock, and being satisfied that the delineated area meets criteria (a)(2) of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board of the Borough of Elmwood Park by way of resolution dated December 12, 2019, recommends unanimously that the Borough of Elmwood Park in its entirety qualifies as an Area in Need of Rehabilitation under the Local Re-Development Housing Law N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et.seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Board has provided its recommendation that the conditions that warrant designating the Borough of Elmwood Park in its entirety as an “Area in Need of Rehabilitation” to the Municipal Council for consideration of adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park adopt the following findings of fact, conclusions, and determinations based on the recommendation of the Borough Planner Topology relying upon their findings, presented in a memorandum dated October 29th, 2019 (the “October 29th Topology Memorandum”) include the fact that 82% of the residential housing structures were built before 1969 and, therefore, are at least 50 years old; and

WHEREAS, the October 29th, 2019 Topology Memorandum and their testimony before the Council, has formed the principal basis for Mayor and Council determining that the Borough of Elmwood Park in its entirety is and should be designated as an “Area in Need of Rehabilitation”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council for the Borough of Elmwood Park, New Jersey, that:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park in its entirety be and is hereby designated as an “Area in Need of Rehabilitation” pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14).

Section 2. The Borough Clerk is hereby directed to serve within ten (10) days a copy of this Resolution upon each person who filed a written objection thereto and stated, in or upon the written submission, an address to which notice of determination may be sent.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be forwarded for approval to the Commissioner of the Department of Community Affairs for the State of New Jersey before this Resolution shall become effective.

Section 4. Upon approval of the Resolution by the Commission of the Department of Community Affairs for the State of New Jersey, the Borough Planning Board is hereby directed and authorized to prepare one or more redevelopment plans indicating that the Borough of Elmwood Park in its entirety has been declared an Area in Need of Rehabilitation pursuant to this resolution, and to make such other amendments as may be necessary and appropriate in furtherance of each redevelopment plan’s goals and objectives.

COMMITTEE REPORTS
