BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY AND NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$2,585,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make various public improvements and to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, in, by and for said Borough, as more particularly described in Section 4 hereof. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purposes"), the respective amounts of money hereinafter stated as the appropriation for said respective purposes. Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that a \$250,000 grant from the County of Bergen Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvements to Rosemont Park described in Section 4.F hereof. Said grant funds shall be applied as set forth in Section 12 hereof. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough.

Section 4. The several purposes hereby authorized for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued are set forth in the following "Schedule of Improvements, Purposes and Amounts" which schedule also shows (1) the amount of the appropriation and the estimated cost of each such purpose, and (2) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance such purposes, and (3) the estimated maximum amount of bonds and notes to be issued for each such purpose, and (4) the period of usefulness of each such purpose, according to its reasonable life, computed from the date of said bonds:

SCHEDULE OF IMPROVEMENTS, PURPOSES AND AMOUNTS

A. (i) Installation of surveillance cameras at various locations and (ii) acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, for the use of the Police Department consisting of (a) SUVs, (b) body cameras and (c) a truck scale.

It is hereby determined and stated that said road being improved is of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

It is hereby determined and stated that said road being improved is of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 5. The cost of such purposes, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$260,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purposes, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 6. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$125,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purposes. The sum of \$125,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purposes.

Section 7. To finance said purposes, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,460,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 8. To finance said purposes, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,460,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 9. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 10. It is hereby determined and declared that the average period of usefulness of said purposes, according to their reasonable lives, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or notes authorized for said purposes, is a period of 21.95 years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 11. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$2,460,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 12. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purposes, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purposes, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purposes shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 13. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 14. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 15. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 16. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE REHABILITATION OR REPLACEMENT OF WATER MAINS AND LINES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE WATER UTILITY OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$240,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to rehabilitate or replace water mains and lines at various locations in, by and for the Water Utility of the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$240,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required for this bond ordinance pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) and 40A:2-7(h). Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$240,000, and (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$240,000, and (5) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$15,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that the Water Utility would have been self-liquidating, as defined in Section 47(a) of the Local Bond Law, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019, had there been included in the interest and debt redemption charges for such year an amount equal to interest for one year at the rate of four and one half percentum (4½%) per annum on said bonds or notes, and the amount of the first installment of serial bonds legally issuable to finance such purpose plus an amount for charges as aforesaid with respect to all bonds and notes authorized but not issued for such Water Utility.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$240,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$240,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of forty years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$240,000, but said \$240,000 shall be deducted from gross debt pursuant to Section 44(c) of the Local Bond Law and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance is permitted by an exception to the debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law as provided in Sections 47(a) and 7(h) of the Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitations as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has been made aware of and has expressed concerns regarding short period rental of dwelling premises located in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, has reviewed, considered and has determined that there is a need for the overall safety, health and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to amend the requirements set forth at §34-7.1 of the Borough's Land Use and Zoning Code so as to restrict and ban the short term rental of dwellings for periods less than twenty eight (28) days in any and all zoning district in the Borough of Elmwood Park; and

WHEREAS, short term rental of dwelling for periods of less than twenty-eight (28) days in the Borough of Elmwood Park are detrimental to issues including noise, overcrowding and parking within the residential neighborhoods of the Borough and may seek to convert residential dwelling units into illegal day-facto hotels, motels, boarding houses and commercial enterprises in violation of the Borough's zoning and other codes as well as State statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to deter and rental of residential dwelling units for less than twenty-eight (28) days within the Borough by regulating such as an illegal use within the Borough: and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough wish to adopt this ordinance in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community at large by prohibiting short term rentals of less than twenty-eight (28) days for residential properties within the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Bergen County, New Jersey, as follows:

1. § 34-7.1 entitled "Residential Uses" is hereby supplemented and amended by adding a new subparagraph "A" that shall read as follows:
 - A. No person shall rent, lease, solicit, advertise for, offer, permit, allow or rent or allow the use or occupancy of any dwelling unit for a period of twenty-eight (28) days or less. Nothing shall prevent lawful rental and occupancy of a dwelling unit for a rental period of more than twenty-eight (28) days.
2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance.
3. In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provisions are declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law and shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, pursuant to the laws of the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. **AN ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS
AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year=s final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2020 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year=s final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$207,001 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Councilman Fasolo wished congratulations to the Elmwood Park competition cheer team. He announced that the district held a dress down fundraiser to support rare diseases and thanked those that participated. He spoke about the new re-registration process as well as the next Board of Education meeting date.

Councilwoman Wechtler shared that there was not a Homeowners Association meeting this month nor a bus fundraiser, but they will both continue in March as she shared the upcoming dates. She went on to discuss the recent Library Board meeting, construction process at the library, grants that have been applied for, and the child programs that are being offered and at full capacity.

Council President Balistrieri updated those in attendance on current and upcoming sport programs provided by the Recreation Center. Additionally, she announced dates for the following upcoming events: Egg Hunt, Community Day, and Food Truck Festival. On behalf of the DPW Councilwoman Balistrieri shared that the Holiday tree from the County's Winter Wonderland has been planted behind the tank on the corner of Market and Mola, the shade trees have been moved to the outside perimeter at the same location, efforts are being made to mitigate the culvert at Martha and Kipp, underpasses have been cleaned, water breaks have been repaired, and the debris at Fleischer's Brook will be cleaned up. She then discussed the latest Council Corner and expressed her satisfaction with the introduction of the 2020 budget and thanked the CFO and Department Heads for their work. Lastly, Councilwoman Balistrieri announced the next Stigma Free Committee meeting.

Councilwoman Pellegrine, on behalf of the Board of Health, reported that there is a new health inspector, the first rabies clinic will be held in May, and shared the next meeting date. She then went on to share that the Chamber of Commerce will be hosting their first breakfast gathering with Mayor Colletti as the guest speaker on February 28th. For the RAP Program, Councilwoman Pellegrine provided details on the latest clean-up and upcoming appreciated breakfast. To conclude her report, she read the latest Police Report.

Councilwoman Ingui provided her Fire Report. She went on to thank the school system for partaking in their fourth annual "black and white day" held to support rare diseases.

Councilman Golabek informed the public that an application will be placed on the March Planning Board agenda for the upcoming Lidl store. He then went on to thank his colleagues that voted to shoot down the admonishment resolutions that were placed on the agenda. He stated that he has only entered the Municipal Building for professional matters only. Councilman Golabek provided the public with a timeline of the recent events that occurred and were discussed during the public meeting. He continued on by questioning the amount of effort the attorneys spent on the related situation and stated he would not take responsibility for the amount of money that was allegedly spent as a result as only \$7,500 for special legal counsel was approved. Councilman Golabek raised concerns on why an employee would ever be publicly admonished as it is not past practice.

Borough Clerk Delaney also stated that she has only entered the Municipal Building for professional matters only. She expressed her disappointment in the fact that a personnel matter is being dealt with publicly and criticized the process & procedures that took place.

Mayor Colletti stated that the Governing Body is working on 5-6 different initiatives to be announced in the future. He also shared that the Borough's JIF Safety Report was close to 0, including the Marcal incident, of which he was very proud of.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jeffrey Freitag, Hillman Drive, questioned the last three resolutions on the agenda. He asked for clarification on the resolution titled "Reaffirming the Appointment of Borough Clerk" as he does not understand how a municipality can reaffirm something that was already done with different people voting. Lastly, Mr. Freitag raised questions regarding monies and applications related to the Library Board.

Gladys Gyskiewicz, Fencsak Avenue, raised concerns about curb conditions. She then went on to address the situation detailed in the last 3 resolutions as the perception of the public is that something unethical occurred. She questioned the relationship between some of the Councilmembers and Borough Clerk and stated she feels Councilman Golabek should resign.

Joseph Dombrowski, Lincoln Avenue, stated that there has never been a policy where a Councilperson could not enter the building/had to ask for permission to enter the building after/before hours. He went on to explain that he himself has entered the building after hours which is why he suggested the Borough invest in key fobs. He congratulated those Councilmembers that voted “no” on the admonishment resolutions as it was the right thing to do. Mr. Dombrowski questioned why additional funding is being spent to hire special legal counsel and tax appeal attorneys when the Borough has an attorney. He expressed that the Borough should decrease the Borough Attorney’s salary, as was past practice, if the Borough Attorney is not going to take on tax appeals. Lastly, Mr. Dombrowski raised his concerns about the Borough hiring an employee that recently sat on the Governing Body.

Michael Bufis, Philip Avenue, requested information regarding the Clerk’s office hours in Elmwood Park and Prospect Park. He also went on to question if the part-time position for the Tax Department/Floater that is currently being advertised is to help the Borough Clerk’s office. Mr. Bufis stated that he feels the individuals involved in the investigation should split the legal fees incurred and asked if said individuals were considered to be trespassing.

Barbara Von Dem Hagen, Orchard Street, suggested that the Borough form a complete count committee for the 2020 census. She also volunteered to be a part of said committee.

Mary Doyle, Stefanic Avenue, questioned whether or not it is standard protocol to make an employee’s personnel records public.

Joseph Delaney, Garden Court North, commended the relationship that the City of Garfield and Borough of Elmwood Park have had in the past. He stated that he is a member of the ticket that selected Mr. Golabek to serve as their campaign manager and that said ticket was able to locate a Local Finance Board opinion that states there is no conflict with an elected official serving as a campaign manager. Mr. Delaney felt that if their ticket was able to locate this decision, a qualified attorney should have been able to as well. He went on to say that as a Councilman in another town, he has to have full faith in his professionals and that he did not see that same full faith here this evening in relation to the professionals who advised the Governing Body to act on the last 3 resolutions.

Magdalena Giandomenico, Chobot Lane, asked which Councilmembers voted to approve the special legal counsel hired in January. She also questioned if the Borough applied for the County’s Census grant.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Wechtler and seconded by Councilman Fasolo to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
