1. CALL TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park was called to order on Thursday, March 19, 2020 at 7:30PM in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 182 Market Street, Elmwood Park, New Jersey.

On Roll Call Councilmembers: Fasolo, Golabek, Ingui, Pellegrine, Wechtler, and Council President Balistrieri. Also present were Mayor Colletti, Borough Administrator Foligno, Borough Clerk Erin Delaney, and Borough Attorney Salvatore Ingraffia.

Due to the Coronavirus, also known as COVID-19, precautionary measures were taken in an attempt to prevent further spread of the virus and to protect the health and public safety of the Governing Body, Borough Professionals, and members of the public. As a result, the public was unable to physically attend the meeting. In order to participate in the meeting, the public was required to use the free access number which was provided and advertised in advance.

Mayor Colletti and Borough Administrator Foligno provided statements addressing the current status of the COVID-19 situation in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

WHEREAS, an application has been filed for a person-to-person, place-place transfer of Plenary Retail Consumption License, 0211-33-025-008, heretofore issued to JGL Entertainment LLC; and

WHEREAS, the submitted application form with the premises to be located at 100 Broadway, Unit 13 is complete in all respects, the transfer fees have been paid, and the license has been properly renewed for the current license term; and

WHEREAS, the applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all standards established by Title 33 of the New Jersey Statutes, regulations promulgated thereunder, as well conditions consistent with Title 33; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has disclosed, and the issuing authority reviewed the source of all funds used in the purchase of the license and the licensed business and all additional financing obtained in connection with the licensed business; and

WHERAS, there was an investigation by the local police department and said investigation revealed that said new premises for licensing are located with 500' (five hundred feet) from another establishment holding a current liquor license; and

WHEREAS, the above referred to investigation revealed that the premises is within the 500' (five hundred feet) distance from a plenary retail distribution license (Metro Liquors) which is 180' (one hundred eighty feet) away; and

WHEREAS, the Council has the right to place restrictive use on said transfer of license and, having considered the findings of the above investigation, concludes that a waiver of the 500' (five hundred feet) distance requirement would be reasonable and fair under the circumstance of this particular case; and

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that this waiver would not be detrimental to the health, safety, morals and the general welfare of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of Elmwood Park does hereby approve, effective March 19, 2020, the transfer of the aforesaid Plenary Retail Consumption License to Hook & Reel Elmwood Inc. and does hereby direct the Municipal Clerk to endorse the license certificate to the new ownership as follows: "This license, subject to all its terms and conditions, is hereby transferred to Hook & Reel Elmwood Inc. effective March 19, 2020."

BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE #20-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH CHAPTER XXII, ENTITLED "STREETS AND SIDEWALKS," MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 22-3 ENTITLED "CURBS AND SIDEWALKS" MORE SPECIFICALLY SUBSECTION 22-3.2 ENTITLED "MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS" SO AS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANGUAGE CLARIFYING THE OBLIGATION AND RESPONSIBILITY SETFORTH THEREIN UNDER CERTAIN SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE

The intent of this Ordinance is to amend the part of the ordinance, to allow the Borough to undertake responsibility of repairing and/or replacing deteriorating street curbs under certain circumstance. Thereby limiting the property owner's obligation, under those specific circumstances, of maintaining and repairing said street curbs.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of health and safety concerns that exist with regards to the conditions of many of the Borough's street curbs, and in order to protect the health and safety of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park and also extending assistance to the residents and owners of properties; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have concluded and determined that the disrepair and deteriorating conditions of certain street curbs are and have become a hazard to the health, safety and the welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have further recognized that under certain circumstances it would be an unreasonable financial burden to place the obligation upon the particular property owner to be responsible for the repair or replacement of any such street curbs and in order to divert and assist the particular property owners and lessen this financial burden.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter XXII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park entitled "Streets and Sidewalks" more specifically section 22-3 entitled "Curbs and Sidewalks" more specifically sub-section 22-3.2 entitled "Maintenance and Repairs" is hereby amended to contain the following language:

"Upon the event, and solely upon such occurrence, that the Borough has or will undertake the obligation to repave any roadway in the Borough and the particular project is approved and bidding has been awarded and work has begun or will begin, the Borough Engineer shall determine if a curb or span has to be replaced. In determining such need, the engineer shall take under consideration the following criteria:

- 1. The curb should be replaced, if upon his sole discretion of the Borough engineer, is determined to be 30% or more of the exposed curb is missing or as recommended by the council. and/or
- 2. The curb should be replaced if upon observation of the Borough engineer, and if it can be observed solely, by visual inspection, that the span is not fixed in place or can be observed to be movable due to the separation from, or lack thereof, subsurface curb to hold the curb in place throughout the duration of the towns improvements to the roadway in question. and/or
- 3. The curb should be replaced if it does not meet certain building code requirements. and/or
- 4. The curb should be replaced if there is compromised integrity where it can be anticipating the curb will break up or will be damaged in the milling process. and/or
- 5. The curb should be replaced if 30% of the exposed curb in any portion thereof is not properly attached to the remainder of the span whereas a span of curb is designated to be non-monolithic and fully separated from the sidewalk, roadway, and any other span of curb. However, 30% is a mere guide and is not a fixed or a requirement but it is stated solely for a guide to logically set a minimal point reference when the curb should need to be replaced.
- 6. At all times, notwithstanding the language in this ordinance, it will remain the discretion of the Mayor and Council to determine after advice of the Borough engineer whether or not any particular curbing should be replaced.

Upon the above replacement and repaving criteria and condition, the property owners adjacent to the said roadway in which the Borough replaces the curbs based upon the above will not be responsible for the costs of the replacement of curb. However, the property owners will continue to be responsible for said curb in the future as set forth in this prior section of the ordinance."

SECTION 2. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 6. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$125,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purposes. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has been made aware of and has expressed concerns regarding short period rental of dwelling premises located in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, has reviewed, considered and has determined that there is a need for the overall safety, health and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to amend the requirements set forth at §34-7.1 of the Borough's Land Use and Zoning Code so as to restrict and ban the short term rental of dwellings for periods less than twenty eight (28) days in any and all zoning district in the Borough of Elmwood Park; and

WHEREAS, short term rental of dwelling for periods of less than twenty-eight (28) days in the Borough of Elmwood Park are detrimental to issues including noise, overcrowding and parking within the residential neighborhoods of the Borough and may seek to convert residential dwelling units into illegal day-facto hotels, motels, boarding houses and commercial enterprises in violation of the Borough's zoning and other codes as well as State statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to deter and rental of residential dwelling units for less than twenty-eight (28) days within the Borough by regulating such as an illegal use within the Borough: and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough wish to adopt this ordinance in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the community at large by prohibiting short term rentals of less than twenty-eight (28) days for residential properties within the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, Bergen County, New Jersey, as follows:

- **1.** §34-7.1 entitled "Residential Uses" is hereby supplemented and amended by adding a new subparagraph "A" that shall read as follows:
 - A. No person shall rent, lease, solicit, advertise for, offer, permit, allow or rent or allow the use or occupancy of any dwelling unit for a period of twenty-eight (28) days or less. Nothing shall prevent lawful rental and occupancy of a dwelling unit for a rental period of more than twenty-eight (28) days.
- 2. Any or all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with any of the terms hereof are hereby repealed to such extent as they are so in conflict or inconsistent with this ordinance.
- **3.** In case any article, section or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid in any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect any other article, section or provision of this ordinance except insofar as the article, section or provisions are declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law and shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.

- 3. Miles Street between Martha Avenue and Kipp Avenue
- 4. Mill Street between Martha Avenue and Kipp Avenue
- 5. Page Street between Martha Avenue and Kipp Avenue
- 6. Ray Street between Martha Avenue and Kipp Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have reviewed those concerns and have determined that it is a necessity to address the concerns of the residents as to parking regulations at the specific locations and find it necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey, pursuant to the laws of the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. WHEREAS, Congress authorized the 1033 Program to make use of excess Department of Defense (DOD) equipment by making it available at the local, county, and state level. This excess DOD equipment has been purchased with taxpayer funds. Law enforcement may request resources from this program. The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) mandates that all acquired 1033 equipment be under the control of the requesting law enforcement agency. The equipment may enhance community preparedness, response, and resiliency while off-setting the costs in a time of fiscal constraints; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 2364 2(a) requires that all local or county law enforcement agencies be approved by resolution by the majority of the full membership of the governing body prior to the transmittal of 1033 Program Application. The DLA requires that applications for program participation be submitted every 365 days; and

WHEREAS, the Elmwood Park Mayor and Council (also herein referred to as the "Council" requires that the designated Law Enforcement Support Offices (LESO) Point of Contact for this venue submit a monthly report regarding acquired 1033 Program property to the Chief Executive Official of the venue. In the event that any property had been obtained contrary to the intent of Senate Bill No. 2364 2(a), the State Coordinator shall be contacted and equipment shall be transferred or returned via the federal inventory database system (FEPMIS); and

WHEREAS, the Elmwood Park Mayor and Council finds that the Elmwood Park Police Department may request and acquire certain DEMIL B through H (controlled) property in the RTD system without restriction and additional resolutions from the Council. However, it has been determined that based on the Elmwood Park Police Department's needs, it may not acquire armored tactical vehicles, marine vessels over 28 feet, aircraft, weapons, or any items deemed without approval of the governing body. Any special application for weapons, aircraft or MRAP's must be authorized by the Council by resolution prior to the submission of the application/requisition; and

WHEREAS, the Elmwood Park Mayor and Council shall have complete oversight of the Elmwood Park Police Department's participation in the Department of Defense - Defense Logistics Agency - Law Enforcement Support Office/1033 Program and of any and all items obtained from the program; and

WHEREAS, the Elmwood Park Mayor and Council recognizes that the acquisition of 1033 Program Property is time sensitive, as resources are allocated to all states based on time stamp of requisition. In the event that a LESO Point of Contact requests an item in good faith and said item is determined to be contrary to the intent of the resolution, the LESO Point of Contact may cancel the request prior to the acquisition of the property, without being in violation of 82364 2(a);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Elmwood Park Mayor and Council hereby authorizes the Elmwood Park Police Department to apply and to continue to participate in the Department of Defense - Defense Logistics Agency - Law Enforcement Support Office/1033 Program; and

Given the circumstances of the meeting, no committee reports were shared by the Governing Body.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Borough Clerk Delaney read the following into the record which was submitted via e-mail by Daniel Flank of Donor Avenue:

- 1. I want to thank Councilman Fasolo for creating the app that has helped me with being informed on trash pick-up. I was always missing my garbage takeout, and this will really help me. Kudos to you!
- 2. With this whole Coronavirus going on, I'm an old gent that's asking if the trash man or woman can get my garbage for me, throw it away, and then bring it right back to my stoop. Is this possible? Thank you in advance.
- 3. What are the height and set back restrictions for a dog house on my front lawn, close to my stoop? I think about these things, just in case the young fellow is not immune to the virus.
- 4. Am I able to play music on my exterior house speakers during the Coronavirus purge during 8PM and 5AM?

Borough Clerk Delaney read the following into the record which was submitted via e-mail by Jeffrey Freitag of Hillman Drive:

- 1. The proposed increase for Resolution R-134-20, Ordinance #20-08 in many cases would be \$500.00. Even in good economic times this is quite a sizeable increase. Considering the tough economic times that most retail establishments are currently facing I feel that this increase is very untimely.
- 2. Has any action been taken by the Library Board regarding the award of a change order for the Electrical Service? I understand the Library Board did not meet on 3/16/20 to possibly take action on this matter. I believe in a situation such as the COVID-19 national health emergency it would certainly permit action by the board to be taken as most board's bylaws permit.
- 3. At last week's Mayor and Council work meeting (3/12/20) the BA, Mike Foligno, brought up that the Elmwood Park taxpayers would be funding, as was done in 2019, Paterson Police Officers to patrol the area of Eastside Park. Please see the attached article from 5/24/19 where Police Chief/BA Foligno is quoted as saying, "It is up to Paterson elected officials to find a long-term fix for this." In my opinion it this should not be paid for by the taxpayers or drug money.

Borough Clerk Delaney read the following into the record which was submitted via e-mail by Dominick Scalcione, of E. 54th Street:

According to County Executive Jim Tedesco at today's news conference, Bergen now has over 200 COVID-19 cases, with 80 new reported cases today and at least one in Elmwood Park.

- 1. If tests confirm a Borough resident is positive, which agency has the task to investigate? If this is an Elmwood Park responsibility, do we have the resources to investigate or do you plan to use staff from other agencies?
- 2. Is some method similar to the RAP Program under consideration to provide neighbor to neighbor help if a resident runs out of food, medicine or other essential items?

Thank you, Mayor, Council and Chief Foligno for the extraordinary efforts you are making on behalf of Elmwood Park residents.

Borough Clerk Delaney read the following into the record which was submitted via e-mail by Brenda McKoy, of Rudolph Avenue:

I am resident and property owner in Elmwood Park for the past 17 years. Will there be any lenience given for property taxes in the midst of this crisis?

Joseph Dombrowski, Lincoln Avenue, questioned why the Mayor and Council spent approximately 35 minutes discussing the tabling of two resolutions for board appointments. He felt and held that an outside influence was the cause of the hold up being Ms. Freitag and Mr. Golembiski upset former Mayor Caramagna in the past, though he hopes it wasn't true. He further went on to say that Councilmembers receive an agenda in advance and it is unacceptable to not raise any questions in reference to the agenda prior to the meeting. Mr. Dombrowski concluded by saying he has no problem with Resolution R-166-20 but that he feels the field may have already been named after Scotty Beckett.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Wechtler and seconded by Councilman Fasolo to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
