INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE

This Ordinance intends to amend a specific section of the police regulation ordinance. It is further the intent of updating the penalties section to increase the minimum fines to deter violations.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have been made aware that an increase of penalties are necessary to deter violations of this sections of the Ordinance for the health, safety and welfare concerns of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park; and same having been recommended by the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have acknowledged and determined that the increase of fines are necessary for the health, safety and the welfare of the public; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park entitled "Police Regulation" more specifically section 3-25.4 entitled "Penalties" is hereby amended and replaced by the following language:

A violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of no less than \$250.00 to an maximum of \$500.00.

SECTION 2. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance, or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH CHAPTER III, ENTITLED "POLICE REGULATIONS," MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 3-1.2 ENTITLED "PROHIBITED NOISES" MORE SPECIFICALLY SUBSECTION 3-1.2h SAME TO BE DELETED AND REPLACED BY THE LANGUAGE CONTAINED HEREIN

INTENT OF THIS ORDINANCE

This Ordinance intends to address and clarify a specific section of the noise ordinance. It is further the intent of updating and clarifying the time to allow construction and repairs in the Borough.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of health, safety and welfare concerns that exist with regards to the Noise conditions in the Borough, and this amended is being introduced to promote the health, safety and welfare concerns of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have acknowledged and determined that the noise level concerns are a hazard to the health, safety and the welfare of the public; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter III of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park entitled "Police Regulation" more specifically section 3-1.2 entitled "Prohibited Noises" more specifically part 3-1.2h is hereby amended and replaced by the following language:

The carrying on of any and all excavation, demolition, construction, repairs or alteration work shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, during May to August, and between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. during September to April, on Saturday it shall be permitted during 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. it shall be prohibited at all other times, including but not limited to the entire day on Sunday and federal holidays.

However, when the homeowner and or tenant carries on any construction, repair, or alteration work on his dwelling, property, or apartment, it shall be permitted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, during May to August. Between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. during the months of September to April, on Saturday it shall be permitted during 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. except for that on Sunday the homeowner or tenant shall be allowed to do so between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and it shall be prohibited at all other times.

Only In case of urgent necessity or emergency for the health, safety, and welfare of the public will the Superintendent of Public Works or Business Administrator or the Chief of Police may grant a permit for excavation, demolition, construction, repair or alteration work for a period not to exceed three days, by the terms of which such work may be carried on between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to make public improvements and to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, in, by and for said Borough, as more particularly described in Section 4 hereof. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purposes"), the respective amounts of money hereinafter stated as the appropriation for said respective purposes. Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough.

Section 4. The several purposes hereby authorized for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued are set forth in the following "Schedule of Improvements, Purposes and Amounts" which schedule also shows (1) the amount of the appropriation and the estimated cost of each such purpose, and (2) the amount of each sum which is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance such purposes, and (3) the estimated maximum amount of bonds and notes to be issued for each such purpose, and (4) the period of usefulness of each such purpose, according to its reasonable life, computed from the date of said bonds:

Section 5. The cost of such purposes, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$15,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purposes, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 6. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$17,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purposes. The sum of \$17,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purposes.

Section 7. To finance said purposes, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$313,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 8. To finance said purposes, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$313,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 9. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 10. It is hereby determined and declared that the average period of usefulness of said purposes, according to their reasonable lives, taking into consideration the respective amounts of bonds or notes authorized for said purposes, is a period of 7.61 years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 11. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$313,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 12. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purposes, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purposes, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purposes shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 14. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Sections 1 and 4 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 15. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE UNDERTAKING OF THE ELMWOOD PARK MARINA IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$1,400,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), is hereby authorized to undertake the Elmwood Park Marina Improvement Project in, by and for the Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$1,400,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvement described in Section 1 of this ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) because this ordinance involves a project to be funded by a State grant. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$250,407 from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Green Acres Program shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 9 hereof. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefitted.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of the Borough, (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of the Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$1,400,000, (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$1,400,000, and (5) the cost of said purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$200,000, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of said purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,400,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$1,400,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance, shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of the Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance,

and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of fifteen years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of the Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$1,400,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of said purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of said purpose or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for said purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 11. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this ordinance.

Section 12. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 13. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

Mayor Colletti stated that the Borough is currently in the process of filling the Recreation Director position and advised that the Borough Building will remain closed for the time being.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Dominick Scalcione, E. 54th Street, followed up in regards to his inquiry of English Avenue Park. He stated that there is still no fence and brush is being left on the field. He also noted that it was nice to see the residents in the area come together during the recent power outage.

Jeffrey Freitag, Hillman Drive, questioned the payment to Alaimo Group for their work on the Tennis Courts and whether or not it was the final payment. He felt that Alaimo should hold some responsibility for the delay of the project. Mr. Freitag then requested more information on the side bar agreement on the consent agenda. Lastly, he confirmed that a third meeting will be held in August on the 27th. Mr. Freitag asked whether or not it would be held teleconference, which he does not agree with being that some individuals do enter the building.

A motion was made by Councilman Fasolo and seconded by Councilwoman Pellegrine to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
