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Prior to proceeding with the Budget Introduction items, the Borough CFO and Borough Auditor gave a brief review of the introduced budget for the members of the public. The Borough CFO advised that initially the increase was much higher but administration worked hard to chip away at that number. He stated that due to the pandemic revenues are down and that he feels, considering the circumstances, the Borough is at a good starting point. Both Mr. Riggitano and Mr. Wielkotz shared that the adopted budget will likely end up having less of an increase per household due to COVID-19 funding.

Mayor Colletti stated that he is disappointed in the projections, though it is not carved in stone, because our residents have also suffered financially as a result of the pandemic. He said that the Borough should not be spending more money than it is bringing in. Mayor Colletti requested that moving forward he received a detailed monthly report on finances.

Councilwoman Wechtler said that the council will work together to lower the number introduced this evening so that the residents are affected as little as possible.

Councilman Golabek advised that while the Mayor makes valid points, in 2007-2009 the economy and Borough were facing tough financial times and the average tax increase to the residents ranged from \$100-\$150. He said that he feels, in comparison, the Borough is at a good starting point especially since new positions were added to the Borough to serve its residents.

CALENDAR YEAR 2021 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 1.0% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the County of Bergen finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2021 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 2.5% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$541,830 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and

WHEREAS the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2021 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$758,562 and that the CY 2021 municipal budget for the Borough of Elmwood Park be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.
