1. CALL TO ORDER:

The Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park was called to order on Thursday, December 16, 2021 at 7:05PM in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 182 Market Street, Elmwood Park, New Jersey. On Roll Call Councilmembers: Balistrieri, Fakhoury, Fasolo*, Golabek, Pellegrine, and Council President Wechtler. Also present were Mayor Colletti, Borough Administrator Foligno, Borough Clerk Erin Delaney, and Borough Attorney Ingrassia.

3. STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE:

Following the swearing-in ceremonies, the Mayor and Council shared their congratulatory remarks to the officers as did Chief Foligno. A short recess was taken following their remarks.

7. MAYORAL VETO ON ORDINANCE 21-27

Mayor Colletti invoked his right to a Mayoral veto on Ordinance 21-27 and reviewed the Borough's bond debt over the years as it has increased. He stated that he recommended utilizing \$400,000 of the American Recovery Plan monies to offset the cost of the drainage portion of the road program in an attempt to lower the bond amount. Councilman Golabek stated that the money could, instead, be used to offset tax increases for two years. Councilwoman Balistrieri made a motion to overturn the Mayoral veto which was seconded by Council President Wechtler and Councilman Fasolo. The motions carried unanimously by the Council.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE CHAPTER XXIV, ENTITLED "WATER" SECTION 24-4 SUBSECTION 24-4.4 ENTITLED "EXCEPTIONS" SO AS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LANGUAGE CREATING A SEASONAL EXCEPTION AND SUBSECTION 24-4.6 ENTITLED "ENFORCEMENT" SO AS TO DESIGNATE OTHER AUTHORIZED BOROUGH OFFICIALS TO ENFORCE THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of certain hardship created on the residence for full compliance with this ordinance and in a effort to address those concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it necessary to allow seasonal discharge of and also create hardship exeptions to certain residents from the restriction setforth in this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter XXIV of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Water" more specifically the reserved section 24-4 and 24-4.6 is hereby amended to read as follow:

24-4 Sump Pump and Groundwater Standard, Rule and Regulation.

24-4.4 Exceptions; Seasonal Waiver

- A. Any sump pump that is discharged to the street, right of way, or premises that is not creating a nuisance prior to the passage of this ordinance will be exempt; however, if at any time after the passage of this ordinance the conditions change and the discharge creates said nuisance, it will be considered non-compliant, and must be rectified in accordance with this ordinance.
- B. Exemptions is hereby allowed by the Borough, in the form of a seasonal waiver, which would allow the property owner to temporarily discharge directly into the street, right of way, between the April 1rst through October 31 of each year. However, the property owners shall not be allowed by the Borough, to discharge said water into the street, right of way, from November 1, through March 31.
- C. The property owners shall allow a Borough employee or designated representative of the Borough to certify that, prior to November 1 of each subsequent year, their discharge water connection has been removed from discharging water into the street, right of way, of the Borough. Failure to provide such certification shall place the property owner in violation and subject to the surcharge penalty as required under this ordinance.
- D. The property owner may request from the Borough and exemption by submitting said request on an official form to be provided by the Borough Building Department for an exemption to be granted in the form of non-seasonal waiver for a particular property owner who can demonstrate undue hardship because of unique or extenuating circumstances. A waiver would allow the property owner to discharge directly into the street, right of way, without seasonal restrictions. The non-seasonal waiver request shall be submitted to the Township Building Department in writing and, at a minimum, identify the property for which the waiver is being requested, the name of the property owner/applicant, and a detailed description of the circumstances justifying the request. Non-seasonal waiver requests shall be submitted on the official form provided by the Borough Building Department.

24-4.6 Enforcement

This chapter shall be enforced by anyone of the following designated Borough officials;

- 1. Building Department, Business Administrator, Police Chief, Director of Public Works, and the Borough Engineer.
- 2. Such shall, in pursuance of his or her duties herein, be deemed, for the purposes of this chapter, the enforcement agency.

SECTION 2. all remaining parts of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect except that any inconsistencies as to the above changes to this ordinance shall be superseded by the amendment herein.

SECTION 3. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, Governor Murphy signed into law PL. 2021, c. 16, known as the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act" (the "Act"), which legalizes the recreational use of marijuana by adults 21 years of age or older, and establishes a comprehensive regulatory and licensing scheme for commercial recreational (adult use) cannabis operations, use and possession; and

WHEREAS, the Act establishes six (6) marketplace classes of licensed cannabis businesses, specifically including a Class 5 Cannabis Retailer license for locations at which cannabis items and related supplies are sold to consumers; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 1a of the Act authorizes municipalities to adopt by ordinance the number of the Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation licenses that will be available in a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park adopted Ordinance which established that two (2) Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation license would be available for a cannabis establishment to operate within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance further established that the Cannabis Cultivation licensee be required to site his, her or its establishment within a designated area of the Borough known as the Cannabis Overlay Zone;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park express their support for ESSENTIAL CANNABIS COMPANY LLC. with respect to its application to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission for a Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation License.**

Nothing in this Resolution shall preclude the Mayor and Council from issuing additional resolutions of municipal support to other applicants, to the extent that may be permissible under the regulations promulgated by the Cannabis Regulatory Commission, nor shall it limit the Mayor and Council's authority with respect to any request for input from the Cannabis Regulatory Commission as to their preferred licensee should more applicants seek licenses within the Borough than are available under Ordinance. The issuance of a license to the license applicant by the Commission would not exceed the limit of such license as authorized by the Ordinance.

Nothing in this Resolution is intended to affirm that ESSENTIAL CANNABIS COMPANY LLC. will ultimately be granted a license from the Borough of Elmwood Park to operate a cannabis business within the Borough as evidence of compliance with the Borough's laws and regulations will be required to be demonstrated by the applicant at the appropriate time.
