BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPROVEMENT OF 15TH AVENUE (FROM EAST 53RD STREET TO EAST 55TH STREET) IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$200,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the improvement of 15th Avenue (from East 53rd Street to East 55th Street), including road resurfacing, construction of ADA compliant sidewalk ramps and drainage, curb and sidewalk improvements, where necessary, in, by and for the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor. It is hereby determined and stated that said road being improved is of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. The sum of \$200,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$136,976 from the Bergen County Community Development Program, pursuant to the Federal Housing and Community Development Act, shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 10 hereof. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvements is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law, and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$200,000, and (4) \$10,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$190,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$30,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$10,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$190,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$190,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$190,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, COUNTY OF
BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, ADOPTING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR
BLOCK 1602, LOTS 2, 3, 4 AND 26 IN THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK
IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING
LAW**

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, NJS.A. 40A: 12A-1, et seq., as amended (the "Redevelopment Law"), authorizes municipalities to determine whether certain parcels of land in the municipality constitute areas in need of rehabilitation or redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Redevelopment Law, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park (the "Borough") on March 17, 2021 adopted Resolution-125-21 authorized and directed the Elmwood Park Planning Board to conduct a preliminary investigation of Block 1602, Lots 2, 3, 4 and 26 to determine whether the area identified met the criteria set forth in the Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2021, the Planning Board held a public hearing in accordance with the Redevelopment Law at which hearing Francis Reiner, PP, the Borough's Special Planner presented a report dated April 21, 2021 entitled, "Preliminary Investigation for Determination of an Area in Need of Redevelopment, Block 1602, Lots 2, 3, 4 and 26";

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Redevelopment Law, the Mayor and Council of the Borough on October 21, 2021, adopted Resolution-402-21 designating Block 1602, Lots 2, 3, 4 and 26 as shown on the Tax Map of the Borough of Elmwood Park as an "Area in Need of Redevelopment, Non-Condemnation" pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate and effectuate the proper redevelopment of Block 1602, Lots 2, 3, 4 and 26, the Mayor and Council of the Borough has determined that there is a need to develop and implement a redevelopment plan pursuant to the authority granted under the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 12A-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough retained the services of DMR Architects, Francis Reiner, PP, the Borough's Special Planner, to prepare a Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, DMR Architects, Francis Reiner, PP has prepared and submitted to the Mayor and Council the Redevelopment Plan entitled "871 River Drive, 7, 9, 15 Norris Street Redevelopment Plan" dated May 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council finds that it is necessary to implement and adopt the proposed Redevelopment Plan entitled "871 River Drive, 7, 9, 15 Norris Street Redevelopment Plan" dated July 2022 prepared by DMR, Architects, Francis Reiner, PP; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plan entitled "871 River Drive, 7, 9, 15 Norris Street Redevelopment Plan" dated July 2022 prepared by DMR, Architects, Francis Reiner, PP, is on file with the Borough Clerk and provides the redevelopment standards for the Property, including but not limited to the goals and objectives as set forth and stipulated in the Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, the Planning Board shall review the Redevelopment Plan and transmit its comments relating to the Redevelopment Plan to the Mayor and Council in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the comments of the Planning Board relating to the Redevelopment Plan, the Mayor and Council will adopt the Redevelopment Plan determining that the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan is in the best interest of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

Section 2. The entitled “871 River Drive, 7, 9, 15 Norris Street Redevelopment Plan” dated July 2022 prepared by DMR, Architects, Francis Reiner, PP and attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted pursuant to the terms of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et. Seq. of the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law.

Section 3. The Zoning Map of the Borough of Elmwood Park and the Zoning Ordinance of the Borough of Elmwood Park is amended to reflect the Redevelopment Plan and to provide for the property.

Section 4. The Mayor and Council hereby declare that it, without the designation of any other redevelopment entity as defined in the Redevelopment Law, shall exercise all of the powers and duties of the redevelopment entity for purposes of clearance, re-planning, development and redevelopment of the Property and without limiting to the generality of the foregoing, shall be the sole body empowered by the Borough to enter into redevelopment agreements with redevelopers, subject to such limitations and requirements as are prescribed by the Redevelopment Law.

Section 5. This Redevelopment Plan may be amended from time to time, by the Mayor and Council, upon compliance with all requirements of all applicable law.

Section 6. The Borough Council hereby finds and determines that pursuant to the entitled “871 River Drive, 7, 9, 15 Norris Street Redevelopment Plan” dated July 2022 prepared by DMR, Architects, Francis Reiner, PP, that there will be a need to designation a Redeveloper and the Redeveloper shall execute a Redevelopment Agreement, and all other documents necessary to bring the project to completion. Accordingly, a site plan and subdivision review shall be filed only by the designated redeveloper with the Elmwood Park Planning Board, prepared within the requirements of the Municipal Land Use Law N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1 et. Seq. in order for the Redevelopment Plan to be effectuated.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION OF NEW ADDITIONAL OR REPLACEMENT EQUIPMENT AND MACHINERY AND A NEW AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLE, INCLUDING ORIGINAL APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT, FOR THE USE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$160,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), is hereby authorized to acquire new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and a new automotive vehicle, including original apparatus and equipment, for the use of the Police Department in, by and for the Borough consisting of (A) an SUV, (B) firearms and (C) active shooter response equipment. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$160,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of the Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of the Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$160,000, and (4) \$8,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$152,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$8,000, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$8,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for the Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$8,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$152,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$152,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance, shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said bond anticipation notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of the Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance, and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of five years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of the Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$152,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

That Chapter VII, “Traffic”, of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park, New Jersey *that portion of Elm Street beginning at Gilbert Avenue intersection though to the Conner where parking facilities begin on the left and the tennis courts on the right and same be designated as a one-way street with the traffic flow moving northerly bound only; and*

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with the law, subject to any approvals that may be required, if necessary, by the New Jersey Department of Transportation and/or the County of Bergen.

SECTION 3. That, upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the appropriate Borough officials and/or employees shall be authorized to post applicable signs in the affected areas.

SECTION 4. That, upon the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be illegal for the motoring public to make drive south bound on Elm Street towards the intersection of Gilbert *Avenue*, the Borough of Elmwood Police Department shall be authorized to enforce the said traffic regulations as a violation of Section 7-18, "One-Way Streets", of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park, New Jersey.

SECTION 5. In the event any section, part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
