WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have become aware of the necessity to regulate the particular four-way intersection of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street for safety concerns of traffic and pedestrian crossing, in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey and pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-140 of the laws of the state of New Jersey the Mayor and Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That by way of this Ordinance the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park do hereby designate and establish a “4-Way Stop” at the intersections of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street in the Borough of Elmwood Park.

SECTION 2: The designated “4-Way Stop” is in the interest of the public and its health, safety and welfare and the inhabitants in and near said intersection.

SECTION 3: The responsible department of the Borough of Elmwood Park shall be responsible and directed through the Borough Administrator to install the necessary “4-Way Stop” signs at the above-mentioned intersection.

SECTION 4: Be it further Ordained by the Mayor and Council that Chapter VII of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park titled "Traffic" more specifically section 7-21 titled “Multi-Way Stop Intersections is hereby amended so as to include thereto the “4-Way Stop” intersection of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street as follows:

7-21 Multi-way stop intersections.

Is hereby amended to include the “4-Way Stop” intersection of Kipp Avenue and Ray Street. That traffic will stop in all direction.

SECTION 5: Penalties for violation. Any person who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in accordance to the respective and appropriate fine sections of the Borough of Elmwood Park and or as set forth in the Laws of the State of New Jersey.

SECTION 6: The Police Chief and the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park, shall assist and enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: Repealer. All Ordinances of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions.: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK CHAPTERS 2 ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE II OFFICES CREATED, SECTION 2-23 TO BE REFERRED TO AS BOROUGH PHYSICIAN AND MEDICAL PROVIDER. SECTION 2-24 THROUGH 26 SHALL REMAIN RESERVED

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have deems it necessary and appropriate to amend the Borough Code to create the position of Borough Physician and Medical Provider so as to allow the Borough flexibility in hiring appropriate medical professionals to provide medical services for Borough employee cases.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: CHAPTER II of the code of the borough of Elmwood Park titled "**ADMINISTRATION**" more specifically **ARTICLE II "OFFICES CREATED" SECTION 2-23** titled "**RESERVED**" shall be titled "**BOROUGH PHYSICIAN AND MEDICAL PROVIDER**".

Section 2-23 shall be amended to be referred to and read "**BOROUGH PHYSICIAN AND MEDICAL PROVIDER**"

Section 2-23.1 Shall be titled to as **Appointment; Term; Removal**.

- (a) The Physician and Medical Provider will be selected annually by the Mayor and Council upon review of proposals submitted pursuant to requests for proposals advertised under the fair and open process described under N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq. Requests for proposals shall be issued annually.
- (b) The Physician and Medical Provider will serve for a period of one year from the date of hire and will be and remain in effect at the pleasure of the Governing Body.

Section 2-23.2 shall be titled to and be read as **Qualifications**.

- (a) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be licensed to practice in the State of New Jersey.
- (b) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be certified by ABIM/ABMS.
- (c) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be a member in good standing in the medical community of the State of New Jersey.
- (d) The Physician and Medical Provider shall be Board Certified and maintain a valid State of New jersey medical license

Section 2-23.2 shall be titled to and be read as **Compensation**.

- (a) The compensation for the Physician and Medical Provider position shall be the sum of \$5,500 annually to be paid in equal monthly installments.

Section 2-23.3 shall be titled to and be read as **Duties**.

- (a) Physician shall be responsible for:
 - 1. Conducting preemployment or preservice medical examinations.
 - 2. Conducting return from illness or injury examinations for any illness or injury lasting more than three days.
 - 3. Providing a written report regarding the findings and status of the policeman or fireman examined regarding his/her fitness for duty.
 - 4. Medical evaluation of injured member officers, municipal member employees and or suspects and detainees
 - 5. Medical evaluation of 504 requests.
 - 6. On site emergency physician services for events and catastrophes.
 - 7. Emergency medical planning for all hazards including CBRN
 - 8. Medical liaison for State and Local DOH
 - 9. Stand by and/or in person, medical coverage of township special events, i.e. July 4th, local emergency, etc.

10. Being available on an on-call basis to schedule physical examinations at other times during the normal business week or arranging for such examination by another physician under his/her direction and control at no additional cost to the Borough of Elmwood Park.
11. Providing an annual physical to member employees of the Borough and members of the fire and police force on a voluntary basis.
12. Medical directions were indicated for policies involving illness or injury
13. Medical review of use of force policies and procedures for potential injuries, when applicable for the police department.
14. Medical coverage and emergency care for training sessions, ie qualifications, UOF, etc.
15. Standing orders and 24/7 consultation for member employees and police, i.e., oxygen, Narcan, EpiPen, ACLS medications, vaccinations, etc.

Section 2-23.5 shall be titled as Compensation.

- (a) The Borough Physician and or Medical Provider shall receive compensation as shall be fixed, from time to time, by general salary ordinance. However, said compensation shall not be reduced during the term of office, except by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Borough Council.

SECTION 2: Repealer.

All of the remaining part of the Ordinance relating to Article II known as Offices Created of the Local Government of the Borough of Elmwood Park to the extent that same are not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until modified or repealed pursuant to law. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies.

SECTION 3: Invalid Provisions

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE UNDERTAKING OF STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS TO MOLA BOULEVARD (FROM LINDEN AVENUE TO PHILIP AVENUE) IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$510,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), is hereby authorized to undertake streetscape improvements to Mola Boulevard (from Linden Avenue to Philip Avenue), including installation of decorative lighting, replacement of curbs and sidewalks and construction of ADA compliant sidewalk ramps in, by and for the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$510,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvements described in Section 1 of this ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) because this ordinance involves a project to be funded by a State grant. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$239,000 from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 hereof. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 9 hereof. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefitted.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of the Borough, (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of the Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$510,000, (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$510,000, and (5) the cost of said purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$80,000, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of said purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$510,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$510,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance, shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of the Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance, and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of the Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$510,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of said purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of said purpose or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for said purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 11. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvements described in Section 1 of this ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this ordinance.

Section 12. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

ORDINANCE# 22-28**

BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPROVEMENT OF GROVE STREET (FROM MOLA BOULEVARD TO VIVINEY STREET) IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$325,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to undertake the improvement of Grove Street (from Mola Boulevard to Viviney Street), including road resurfacing, construction of ADA compliant sidewalk ramps and drainage, curb and sidewalk improvements, where necessary, in, by and for the Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor. It is hereby determined and stated that said road being improved is of "Class B" or equivalent construction as defined in Section 22 of the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law").

Section 2. The sum of \$325,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvement described in Section 1 of this ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized by this ordinance. No down payment is required pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-11(c) because this ordinance involves a project to be funded by a State grant. It is anticipated that a grant in the amount of \$206,000 from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 hereof. Said grant funds shall be applied as set forth in Section 9 hereof. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said purpose is not a current expense of the Borough, (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of the Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law, (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$325,000, (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$325,000, and (5) the cost of said purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$50,000, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of said purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bonds of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$325,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of the Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$325,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 6. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance, shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of the Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance, and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of the Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of the Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$325,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 9. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of said purpose shall be applied to the payment of the cost of said purpose or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for said purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 10. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 11. The Borough intends to issue bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 12. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 13. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

CULTIVATION AND MANUFACTURING LICENSE TO OPERATE WITHIN THE BOROUGH
OF ELMWOOD PARK**

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, Governor Murphy signed into law PL. 2021, c. 16, known as the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act" (the "Act"), which legalizes the recreational use of marijuana by adults twenty-one (21) years of age or older, and establishes a comprehensive regulatory and licensing scheme for commercial recreational (adult use) cannabis operations, use and possession; and,

WHEREAS, the Act establishes six (6) marketplace classes of licensed cannabis businesses, specifically including a Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation and Manufacturing License for locations at which cannabis can be cultivated and manufactured; and,

WHEREAS, Section 31a of the Act authorizes municipalities to adopt by ordinance the number of the Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation and Manufacturing Licenses that will be available in a municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park adopted an Ordinance which established that two (2) Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation and Manufacturing Licenses would be available for a cannabis establishment to operate within the Borough (the "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Ordinance created a Cannabis and Marijuana Administrative Board (the "Board") to act as the local Agency to process and administer the licensing procedures for the Borough and to make recommendations regarding same for submission to the Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance further established that the Cannabis cultivation and manufacturing licensee be required to site his, her or its establishment within a designated area of the Borough known as the Cannabis Overlay Zone; and;

WHEREAS, NJCURED LLC, completed and submitted the required application and documentation to the Borough of Elmwood Park Cannabis and Marijuana Administrative Board required pursuant to Ordinance No.: 2113, Section 4-7.3(D)(1); and

WHEREAS, after careful review of the application, documentation submitted and a meeting with NJCURED LLC, the Borough of Elmwood Park's Cannabis and Marijuana Administrative Board recommends, by way of the attached resolution, to the Mayor and Council the issuance of one (1) Class 1 Cultivation and Manufacturing License to NJCURED LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that pursuant to the recommendation of the Elmwood Park Cannabis and Marijuana Administrative Board of the Borough of Elmwood Park, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Council hereby, after consideration of the recommendation made by the Elmwood Park Cannabis and Marijuana Administrative Board to approve the issuance to NJCURED LLC of one of its Class 1 Cannabis Cultivation and Manufacturing Licenses based on satisfying the Board's approval and the requirements ordinance.
2. The Borough Zoning Official has confirmed that NJCURED LLC's location at 21 Wallace Street is located in the I-G zone, which is suitable for cannabis cultivation and manufacturing.

3. The issuance of a license to the license applicant by the Commission would not exceed the limit of such licenses as authorized by the Ordinance.

Nothing in this Resolution shall preclude the Mayor and Council from issuing additional resolutions of municipal support to other applicants, to the extent that may be permissible under the regulations promulgated by the Cannabis Regulatory Commission, nor shall it limit the Mayor and Council's authority with respect to any request for input from the Cannabis Regulatory Commission as to their preferred licensee should more applicants seek licenses within the Borough than are available under the Ordinance.

Nothing in this Resolution is intended to affirm that NJCURED LLC. will ultimately be granted a license from the Borough of Elmwood Park to operate a cannabis business within the Borough as evidence of compliance with the Borough's laws and regulations will be required to be demonstrated by the applicant at the appropriate time.
