AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR BLOCK 1202, LOT 21, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING LAW

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et. seq. (the "Redevelopment Law") by Resolution 206-22, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park directed the Elmwood Park Planning Board (the "Planning Board") to undertake a preliminary investigation to determine whether Block 1202, Lot 21 qualify as an area in need of redevelopment as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of its preliminary investigations in accordance with the Redevelopment Law, on December 14, 2022 the Planning Board determined Block 1202, Lot 21 to be areas in need of redevelopment, and recommending that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park designate the areas as such; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council adopted Resolution 440-22 on December 15, 2022 concurring with the Planning Board's findings and designated Block 1202, Lot 21 as an area in need of redevelopment as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-14; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the resolution designating Block 1202, Lot 21 as an area in need of redevelopment, the Borough authorized the Borough Planners, DMR Architects, to prepare a Redevelopment Plan for Block 1202, Lot 21 dated February 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance (the "Redevelopment Plan") and which shall be referred to the Planning Board for its review and consideration pursuant to NJSA 40A:12A-7 and 15; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, the Planning Board shall within 45 days after referral by the Borough Council, transmit to the Borough Mayor and Council, a report containing its recommendation concerning the redevelopment plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7 & 15; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of the Planning Board's recommendation or if the Planning Board fails to transmit a recommendation within 45 days after referral, the Borough Mayor and Council shall act upon this Ordinance adopting the Redevelopment Plan pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough that Block 1202, Lot 21 be redeveloped in accordance with the Redevelopment Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Adoption of Redevelopment Plan.

The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park hereby adopts the Redevelopment Plan entitled, "689 River Drive Redevelopment Plan" dated February 2023 as the redevelopment plan for Block 1202, Lot 21.

2. Amendment of Zoning Map

The Zoning Map of the Borough of Elmwood Park, adopted as Ordinance _____ referred to in Section _____ of the Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended to reflect the Redevelopment Plan and to provide for Block 1202, Lot 21.

3. Redevelopment Entity

The Mayor and Council hereby declares that it, without the designation of any other redevelopment entity as defined in the Redevelopment Law, shall exercise all of the powers and discharge all of the duties of the redevelopment entity for purposes of clearance, re-planning, development and redevelopment of Block 1202, Lot 21 without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall be the sole body empowered by the Borough to enter into redevelopment agreements with redevelopers subject to such limitations and requirements as are prescribed by the Redevelopment Law.

4. Procedures for Amendment of Redevelopment Plan

This Redevelopment Plan may be amended from time to time, by the Mayor and Council, upon the compliance with all requirements of all applicable law.

5. Severability

If any section, sentence or any other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but shall be confined in its effect to the section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.

6. <u>Inconsistent Ordinance Repealed</u>

All other ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

7. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have been and are aware of multiple complaints from the residents regarding vehicle parking in certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that there is a need to limit and or prohibit and control such parking in certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that such limitation, control, and or prohibition would advance the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that Chapter VII, Article 7-13.1 is hereby amended so as to reflect the following wording:

No person shall park any vehicle at the following restricted location as described as follows:

From the intersection of Mulberry Street and Elmhurst Street, along the northern curb line, to a point 248 feet east and terminating 260 feet east of that intersection, to cover the curb area between Block 1020 Lot 28 and Block 1020 Lot 27.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that if any provision of this amended Ordinance shall be held invalid or contrary to the law, then such provision of the Ordinance shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of the Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park that all other language contained therein shall still be valid and remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Amended Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

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BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF A SYNTHETIC TURF ATHLETIC FIELD AT BOROUGH PARK IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$2,310,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to install a synthetic turf athletic field at Borough Park in, by and for the Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials, equipment and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$2,310,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvement described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that the following grants shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the purpose (A) \$441,239 from the County of Bergen Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund and (B) \$144,447 from the County of Bergen. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 10 hereof. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvement is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$2,310,000, and (4) \$110,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$2,200,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$250,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$110,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$110,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,200,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,200,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$2,200,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy <u>ad valorem</u> taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 14. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the first publication thereof after final passage.

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, NJS.A. 40A: 12A-l, et seq., as amended (the "Redevelopment Law"), authorizes municipalities to determine whether certain parcels of land in the municipality constitute areas in need of rehabilitation or redevelopment; and



Lastly, she took a moment to share sympathy for Pastor Ron and his Wife Clair for the fire they endured and how she's thankful no one was hurt.

Mayor Colletti did not have a report at this time.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Kenney stated the road leading to his driveway is a public road and asked why there were cones there blocking it. He then asked for the Borough to recognize WWE wrestler from Elmwood Park. Lastly, he asked about sound barriers being added along route 80.
