AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE AND ALL GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH; MORE SPECIFICALLY, SECTION 9, CHAPTER 4, ENTITLED LICENSING AND BUSINESS REGULATIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have previously recognized that certain clarifications that were necessary with Ordinance 21-13 and enacted Ordinance 22-04 to amend and supplement Ordinance 21-13 in order to clarify said ordinance; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

- A. **Maximum Number of Licenses.** The maximum number of licenses shall be amended to reflect that the Borough may issue no more than three (3) of each of Class I; Four(4) of Class II.

BE IT ORDAINED FURTHER ORDAINED by the mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park as follows:

- D. **Issuance of Class IV and Class V Licenses.** that the Mayor and Council are satisfied that the issuance of these licenses is hereby determined to be in the best interest of the Borough. That the issuance of said licenses is hereby authorized

SECTION 1. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be a part of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park as though codified and fully set forth therein. The Borough Clerk shall have this ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Code.

The Borough Clerk and the Borough Attorney are authorized and directed to change any Chapter, Article, and/or Section number of the Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between the numbers and the existing Code, and in order to avoid confusion and possible accidental repeaters of existing provisions not intended to be repealed.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII, “TRAFFIC” OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, MORE SPECIFICALLY ARTICLE 7-14.1, “PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN DAYS”

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park have been made aware of the necessity to control the parking and limit such parking on a parking lot owned by the Borough located south of Elmhurst Street between Elmhurst Street and Mulberry Street; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that there is a need to limit and or prohibit and control such parking in that certain area; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that that particular parking lot should be utilized and be designated as a Borough employee parking area, exclusively used by the Borough employees during normal standing work hours, thereby assisting in the well-being and improving the productivity of the Borough employees; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that such limitation, control, and or prohibition would advance the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that Chapter VII, Article 7-14.1 is hereby amended so as to reflect the following wording:

No person shall park any vehicle on said parking lot between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday except for Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays and same shall be designated as “**BOROUGH EMPLOYEE PARKING ONLY**” for the designated time restriction.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council, that the Borough Administrator, be and is hereby authorized to provide and issue to each and every employee of the Borough a placard to be placed and hung on the rearview mirror of the employee’s automobile so as to identify that vehicle as a vehicle used and or owned and or operated by a Borough employee.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDAINED, that any unauthorized vehicle parked in said designated parking lot during the hours set forth herein without a placard card visible on its rearview mirror shall be considered as a violation of this ordinance and shall be subject to any and all penalties and recourse as set forth in the Borough code relating to such violation.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that if any provision of this amended Ordinance shall be held invalid, or contrary to the law, then such provision of the Ordinance shall be deemed separable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance and shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of the Ordinance.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED, by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, that all other language contained therein shall still be valid and remain in full force and effect.

BE IT, FURTHER ORDANED, this Amended Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 2-27.27.2 ENTITLED "POLICE
CHAPLAINS," SAME TO BE AMENDED TO CONTAIN THE
FOLLOWING LANGUAGE HEREIN**

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Elmwood Park, by ordinance, had adopted and has appointed one or more chaplains to the Police Department or force pursuant to **N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141**; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that a need has arisen to clarify further and redefine the position(s) of a chaplain(s) in the Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, County of Bergen, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2-27.27 D is hereby amended and replaced with the following language:

D.1 Authority.

- a. The office of the Chaplain is to be of service to the Chief of Police, officers, patrolmen, their families, and the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park.
- b. The Chaplain is a staff assistant to the Chief and may be consulted for any purpose by the Chief or supervisory people. It is understood that all communications with the Chaplain, whether of a personal or professional nature by members of the Police Department, will be held in confidence.
- c. The Chaplain shall be a sworn officer of the Police Department of the Borough of Elmwood Park but is foremost a duly ordained minister and an experienced representative of his or her denomination. It shall be the responsibility of the Police Department to provide the Chaplain with necessary insurance, uniforms, and equipment.
- d. The Chaplain is considered a staff assistant to the Chief of Police and is authorized to act in his name where the presence of police officers requires the assistance of the Chaplain. When on duty, the Chaplain shall be properly distinguished by his insignia and identification and shall conduct himself in a manner becoming his role and denomination.

D.2 Duties and responsibilities.

A. The Chaplain is requested to perform the following duties and such other duties that the Chief of Police may request:

1. Assist Police Department officials in informing families receiving serious injury or death.
2. When an officer is seriously injured or killed on duty, respond to the hospital on request and work with the hospital staff and hospital chaplain according to standard and ethical courtesies.
3. Visit sick or injured police personnel at home or in the hospital.
4. Attend and participate in funerals of active and retired members of the Police Department.
5. Counsel officers with personal problems.
6. Conduct memorial services.
7. Participate in in-service training programs.
8. Attend departmental graduations, promotions, award ceremonies, and other invocations and benedictions.
9. Assist in programs and plans for youthful offenders.
10. Assist in improving public relations.
11. Notify, as soon as possible, an involved person's clergyman in case of a death or serious accident.
12. Make proper referrals in unique cases which need specialized attention.

B. The Chaplain shall also produce monthly reports detailing his activities and a yearly report to be submitted to the Chief of Police, the Mayor, and the Borough Council.

- C. The Chaplain should meet on a regular basis with the Chief of Police and superior officers for the purpose of ongoing evaluation, developing programs, and discussion of departmental morale.

D.3 Regulations and procedure.

A. The Chaplain should have a working knowledge of the duties of law enforcement officers shall, keep abreast of new procedures, and be willing to attend training sessions and programs. In addition, the Chaplain shall comply with the following procedures:

1. The Chaplain shall conform to all police procedures and department regulations insofar as applicable.
2. The Chaplain shall be on a telephone call with the Chief of Police, Department members, and dispatchers.
3. The Chaplain shall not publicly comment on any law enforcement officer, department official, or department policy or action.
4. The Chaplain shall not release any information to the public without the approval of the Chief of Police and the person or officers involved.

SECTION 2. In the event any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance, or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION 4. The remaining section of the ordinance will remain unchanged only to the degree that such is inconsistent with the change made hereto that will supersede.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park has heretofore authorized the undertaking of streetscape improvements to Mola Boulevard (from Linden Avenue to Philip Avenue) in, by and for the Borough and appropriated the sum of \$510,000 therefor pursuant to Ordinance No. 22-27 adopted by the Borough Council of said Borough on November 10, 2022; and

It is anticipated that a \$239,000 grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the improvement authorized by the Prior Ordinance. Said grant funds shall be applied as set forth in Section 9 of the Prior Ordinance or Section 8 hereof. Said improvement has been and shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof has been nor shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvement (hereinafter referred to as "purpose") is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose authorized by the Prior Ordinance is \$740,000, including the sum of \$510,000 appropriated by the Prior Ordinance and the \$230,000 appropriated by this ordinance, and (4) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$740,000, including the \$510,000 authorized by the Prior Ordinance and the \$230,000 hereinafter authorized, and (5) the cost of such purpose includes the aggregate amount of \$110,000, including the sum of \$80,000 stated in the Prior Ordinance and the sum of \$30,000 hereby stated, which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$230,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Section 6. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 7. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$230,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

Section 8. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 9. The Borough intends to issue bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement authorized by the Prior Ordinance and described herein. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of such bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this ordinance.

Section 10. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.

Section 11. BOND ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE INSTALLATION OF A SYNTHETIC TURF ATHLETIC FIELD AT BOROUGH PARK IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF ELMWOOD PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$2,310,000 TO PAY THE COST THEREOF, TO MAKE A DOWN PAYMENT, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE SUCH APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN ANTICIPATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey (the "Borough") is hereby authorized to install a synthetic turf athletic field at Borough Park in, by and for the Borough. Said improvement shall include all work, materials, equipment and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

Section 2. The sum of \$2,310,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of making the improvement described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be met from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds authorized and the down payment appropriated by this ordinance. It is anticipated that the following grants shall be received by the Borough to finance the cost of the purpose (A) \$441,239 from the County of Bergen Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund and (B) \$144,447 from the County of Bergen. Any of said grant funds so received shall be applied as set forth in Section 10 hereof. Said improvement shall be made as a general improvement and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 3. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) the making of such improvement is not a current expense of said Borough, and (2) it is necessary to finance said purpose by the issuance of obligations of said Borough pursuant to the Local Bond Law (Chapter 2 of Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes Annotated, as amended; the "Local Bond Law"), and (3) the estimated cost of said purpose is \$2,310,000, and (4) \$110,000 of said sum is to be provided by the down payment hereinafter appropriated to finance said purpose, and (5) the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes necessary to be issued for said purpose is \$2,200,000, and (6) the cost of such purpose, as hereinbefore stated, includes the aggregate amount of \$250,000 which is estimated to be necessary to finance the cost of such purpose, including architect's fees, accounting, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses and other expenses, including interest on such obligations to the extent permitted by Section 20 of the Local Bond Law.

Section 4. It is hereby determined and stated that moneys exceeding \$110,000, appropriated for down payments on capital improvements or for the capital improvement fund in budgets heretofore adopted for said Borough, are now available to finance said purpose. The sum of \$110,000 is hereby appropriated from such moneys to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 5. To finance said purpose, bonds of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,200,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law. Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law. All matters with respect to said bonds not determined by this ordinance shall be determined by resolutions to be hereafter adopted.

Section 6. To finance said purpose, bond anticipation notes of said Borough of an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2,200,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the Local Bond Law in anticipation of the issuance of said bonds. In the event that bonds are issued pursuant to this ordinance, the aggregate amount of notes hereby authorized to be issued shall be reduced by an amount equal to the principal amount of the bonds so issued. If the aggregate amount of outstanding bonds and notes issued pursuant to this ordinance shall at any time exceed the sum first mentioned in this section, the moneys raised by the issuance of said bonds shall, to not less than the amount of such excess, be applied to the payment of such notes then outstanding.

Section 7. Each bond anticipation note issued pursuant to this ordinance shall be dated on or about the date of its issuance and shall be payable not more than one year from its date, shall bear interest at a rate per annum as may be hereafter determined within the limitations prescribed by law and may be renewed from time to time pursuant to and within limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law. Each of said notes shall be signed by the Mayor and by a financial officer and shall be under the seal of said Borough and attested by the Borough Clerk or Deputy Borough Clerk. Said officers are hereby authorized to execute said notes and to issue said notes in such form as they may adopt in conformity with law. The power to determine any matters with respect to said notes not determined by this ordinance and also the power to sell said notes, is hereby delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, who is hereby authorized to sell said notes either at one time or from time to time in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the period of usefulness of said purpose, according to its reasonable life, is a period of ten years computed from the date of said bonds.

Section 9. It is hereby determined and stated that the Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Borough Clerk of said Borough, and that such statement so filed shows that the gross debt of said Borough, as defined in Section 43 of the Local Bond Law, is increased by this ordinance by \$2,200,000 and that the issuance of the bonds and notes authorized by this ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.

Section 10. Any funds received from private parties, the County of Bergen, the State of New Jersey or any of their agencies or any funds received from the United States of America or any of its agencies in aid of such purpose, shall be applied to the payment of the cost of such purpose, or, if bond anticipation notes have been issued, to the payment of the bond anticipation notes, and the amount of bonds authorized for such purpose shall be reduced accordingly.

Section 11. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 12. The Borough intends to issue the bonds or notes to finance the cost of the improvement described in Section 1 of this bond ordinance. If the Borough incurs such costs prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes, the Borough hereby states its reasonable expectation to reimburse itself for such expenditures with the proceeds of such bonds or notes in the maximum principal amount of bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance.

Section 13. The full faith and credit of the Borough are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited and general obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Borough for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds and notes, without limitation as to rate or amount.
