AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE AND ALL GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH; MORE SPECIFICALLY, CREATING AND ESTABLISHING UNDER CHAPTER 33 NEW ORDINANCE INTITLED “BUSINESS AND RENTAL INSURANCE REGISTRATION” TO PERMIT, REQUIRE AND REGULATE THE PRODUCTION OF INSURANCE CERTIFICATES

INTENT

It is the intention of this chapter to comply with the requirements imposed upon the Borough by the laws of the state of New Jersey more specifically N.J.S.A. 40A:10A-2 which requires for the annual registration of certificates of insurance by business owners and the owners of rental units located in the Borough.

WHEREAS, The State of New Jersey legislature and the Governor signed into law P.L. 2022. C. 92 instituting a new minimum liability insurance requirement for owners of businesses and rental units whether residential or non-residential.; and

WHEREAS, Such owners will be required to annually register the certificate of insurance in the municipality where the business or rental unit is located.; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Elmwood Park is required to adopt an ordinance implementing said legislation.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED, That the Mayor and Council do hereby create and establish by way of adoption of this Ordinance amending the Borough Code to utilize the reserved Chapter 33 which will be amended to be known as the “Business and Rental Unit Liability Insurance”.

33-1. Business and Rental Unit Liability Insurance

33-1.1 Insurance requirements.

Owners of a business, rental unit(s), and/or multifamily homes of four or less units shall be required to have liability insurance as follows:

- A. Owners of a business and/or rental unit(s) shall maintain a minimum of \$500,000 in liability insurance for negligent acts and omissions.
- B. Owners of multifamily homes of four or less units, one of which is owner occupied, shall maintain a minimum of \$300,000 in liability insurance for negligent acts and omissions. A multifamily home of four or less which is not owner occupied are not exempt from showing proof of liability insurance, and they must obtain and register liability insurance of \$500,000.
- C. The liability insurance for owners of a businesses, rental unit(s), and/or multifamily homes of four or less units, one of which is owner occupied, shall include, but is not limited to, coverage for property damage and bodily injury to or death of one or more persons in any one accident or occurrence.

33-1.2. Annual registration requirements.

- A. Any owner of a business or rental unit or unit required to maintain insurance as set forth in this chapter is required to annually file a copy of a certificate of insurance demonstrating compliance with P.L. 2022, c. 92, with the Borough Clerk as follows:
 - (1) Within 30 days of the date this chapter takes effect;

- (2) Within 30 days of the date of establishment of said business or rental unit (s) within the Borough of East Rutherford;
- (3) On or before January 15 of each year following the enactment of this chapter.

- B. A new certificate will be required annually for each calendar year. All certificates shall be renewed no later than January 15 of each calendar year.
- C. Upon filing of an insurance certificate, the Borough Clerk shall issue a certificate of registration to the owner stating the amount of coverage and the policy period of the insurance policy or policies evidenced by the certificate of insurance.

33-1.3 Licensing two or more businesses or locations.

- A. In the event that two or more businesses occupy the same location, the owner shall be required to complete a separate municipal registration form and obtain a separate certificate of insurance for each business.
- B. In the event that the same owner conducts business at two or more locations, a separate business registration form shall be required for each location.

33-1.4 Compliance with applicable laws and ordinances.

- A. Issuance of a municipal insurance registration certificate by the Borough Clerk does not evidence compliance with any other applicable rules, regulations, ordinances, and statutes of the municipality, County or State of New Jersey, or any other regulatory agencies having jurisdiction.

33-1.5 Registration fee.

- A. The filing fee to be paid for each certificate of insurance filed with the Borough Clerk shall be the sum of \$100.

33-1.6 Violations and penalties.

- A. Any owner who fails to comply with this chapter may be subject to a fine not less than \$500 but no more than \$5,000. The Code Enforcement Official may bring this action in Municipal Court or Superior Court as a summary proceeding under the "Penalty Enforcement Law of 1999," P.L. 1999, c. 274 (N.J.S.A. 2A:5 8-10 et seq.), and any penalty monies collected shall be paid to the Borough of Elmwood Park.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND RESOLVED, That the Mayor and Council do hereby amend the Borough Code of the Borough of Elmwood Park to create and establish this new division known as the "Business and Rental Unit Liability Insurance" by amend and supplement the Code more specifically section 33 (reserved) to be entitled "Business and Rental Unit Liability Insurance" of the Borough of Elmwood Park."

SECTION 2. In the event any section, part, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

**AN ORDINANCE AMMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE AMENDDDING
CHAPTER 17 “ENVIORNMENTAL REGULATION” MORE
SPECIFICALLY SECTION 17.1 LEAD PAINT TO THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH CONCERNING LEAD-BASED PAINT INSPECTIONS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to P.L. 2021, c.182, all municipalities are now required to inspect every single-family, two-family, and multiple rental dwelling located within the municipality at tenant turnover for lead-based paint hazards; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the Borough of Elmwood Park to amend the Borough Code at this time to require inspections for lead-based paint in residential rental dwellings to conform with New Jersey State law;

WHEREAS the Borough wishes through this Ordinance to amend Chapter 17.1 entitled “Lead-Paint” of the Borough Code in order to serve the best interests of the Borough and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Elmwood Park, in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17.1 known as “Lead Paint.” is hereby added to include the following section and shall read as follows:

Chapter 17.1 Lead Paint.

17-1.1 Definitions.

Lead Abatement – Measures designed to permanently eliminate lead-based paint hazards in accordance with standards established by the Commissioner of Community Affairs in compliance with standards promulgated by the appropriate federal agencies.

Lead-based Paint Hazard – Any condition that causes exposure to lead from lead-contaminated dust or soil or lead-contaminated paint that is deteriorated or present in surfaces that would result in adverse human health effects.

Visual Assessment – A visual examination for deteriorated paint or visible surface dust, debris, or residue.

Tenant turnover – The time at which all existing occupants vacate a dwelling unit and all new tenants move into the dwelling unit.

17-1.5 Violations.

a. Penalties for violation of Chapter 17.1 shall be as follows:

1. If a property owner has failed to conduct the required inspection or initiate any remediation as required by N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.1 et seq. the owner shall have 30 days to cure the violation.
2. If a property owner fails to cure the violation after 30 days, the property owner shall be subject to a penalty not to exceed \$1,000.00 per week until the required inspection has been conducted or remediation efforts have been initiated.

17-1.7 Removal of Lead Paint or particles

- a. If lead-based paint hazards are identified, then the owner, landlord, and/or agent of the dwelling shall remediate the lead-based paint hazard using lead abatement or lead-based control methods in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.16(d). Upon the remediation of the lead-based paint hazard, the Borough’s lead evaluation contractor shall conduct an additional inspection of the unit to certify that the hazard no longer exists.

- b. If no lead-based paint hazards are identified, then the Borough's lead evaluator shall certify the dwelling as lead-safe on a form prescribed by the Department of Community Affairs, which shall be valid for two (2) years.

17-1.8 Inspections.

- a. All lead evaluation shall be conducted by the Borough Building Department which shall inspect every single-family, two-family, or multiple rental dwelling located in the Borough of ELMWOOD PARK for lead-based paint hazards through visual assessment and dust wipe sampling in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.1 et seq.
- b. Inspections shall be conducted in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.16(c), a dwelling unit in a single-family, two-family, or multiple rental dwelling shall not be subject to inspection and evaluation for the presence of lead-based paint hazards if the unit:
 - (1) Has been certified to be free of lead-based paint;
 - (2) Was constructed during or after 1978;
 - (3) Is in a multiple dwelling that has been registered with the Department of Community Affairs as a multiple dwelling for at least ten (10) years, either under the current or a previous owner, and has no outstanding lead violations from the most recent cyclical inspection performed on the multiple dwelling under the "Hotel and Multiple Dwelling Law," P.L.1967, c.76 (C.55:13A-1 et seq.);
 - (4) Is a single-family or two-family seasonal rental dwelling which is rented for less than six months duration each year by tenants that do not have consecutive lease renewals; or
 - (5) Has a valid lead-safe certification.
- c. The owner, landlord, and/or agent of every single-family, two-family, or multiple rental dwelling unit offered for rental shall be required to obtain an inspection of the unit for lead-based paint hazards every three (3) years, or at tenant turnover, whichever is earlier.

17-1.11 Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.16(e), property owners shall:

- a. Provide evidence of valid lead-safe certification and the most recent tenant turnover at the time of the cyclical inspection
- b. Provide evidence of a valid lead-safe certification obtained pursuant to this Section to new tenants of the property at the time of tenant turnover unless not required to have had an inspection by a lead evaluation contractor or permanent local agency pursuant to §83-2(C) of this Chapter.
- c. Maintain records of lead-safe certification, which shall include name(s) of the unit tenant(s), if inspection was conducted during a period of tenancy.

17-1.12 Fees.

- a. Fees shall be in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.16(h), an additional fee of \$100 initial inspection, and \$50 for a follow up inspection. \$20.00 per dwelling unit inspected by the Borough's, unless the owner demonstrates that the Department of Community Affairs has already assessed an additional inspection fee of \$20.00. The fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited into the Lead Hazard Control Assistance Fund.
- b. In a common interest community, any inspection fee charged pursuant to this subsection shall be the responsibility of the unit owner and not the homeowners' association, unless the association is the owner of the unit.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this Amendment shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section,

paragraph, subsection, clause, or provisions so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective;

SECTION 3. If any ordinances or parts thereof are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance those provisions shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.
